

May 13 2020

To the Pastors, Deacons, Leaders and Congregations of Minnesota,

Since we learned of the first confirmed case of COVID-19 in Minnesota on March 6, through the first stay at home order and its extensions to the moment of our writing today, we have lived in a rapidly changing reality. It has been over two months of transition and exploration, of creativity and innovation, of uncertainty and grief. Circumstances continue to evolve.

We are, as of this writing still living under Governor Walz's extended stay at home order. We know even as the current order expires, as is expected on May 18, things will not simply go back to the way they were.

We give thanks for you and all the ways you have remained flexible and faithful, striving to serve your congregations and ministry sites in the midst of this ever-changing reality. We acknowledge that innovation and experimentation will continue and that faithful responses may be as varied as the contexts we serve. We know there are multiple precautions to take as new challenges arise. The logistics of gathering when it is safe and wise to do so, the special concerns around singing and communion distribution, the reality that there will be those who desire to participate that cannot, these are only some of the myriad pieces we consider.

We the six bishops of the ELCA in Minnesota share particular values as we live and lead together - with you in this pandemic reality. We continue to engage with and listen to state and local officials. We look to scientists and epidemiologists to guide our decision making. We keep ever before us a commitment to the wellbeing of our neighbors, those in our congregations, communities and beyond. We remain focused on our shared vocation of proclaiming the gospel.

It is the good news of Jesus Christ, crucified and risen, that anchors our hope. As we continue to discern how to enter this next phase of life, we are committed to working together. We know particularities will vary with the specificities of context yet our shared values remain. As more detailed guidance is made available from the CDC and MN Department of Health we will continue to collaborate as we offer best practices in light of our shared values.

As we hold you in prayer, we give God thanks for your faithful witness to the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Messiah Lutheran Church Council Meeting April 14, 2020

President Larry called the meeting to order in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Devotions were led by Jodie.

Keith made a motion to accept the agenda with the addition of conversations pertaining to the Zoom meeting the President has every Monday with the Bishop and possible renting of the parsonage. Seconded by Karyn.

Shelly made a motion to accept the Secretary's report as submitted. Seconded by Jodie

Karyn made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as submitted. Seconded by Bonnie

Jay's report was reviewed. Comments were made and discussed from various community members how well he did on Easter Sunday.

Aimee gave report about the Zoom account that the church has set up. Her and Jay facilitate the meetings. She had submitted her letter of resignation with her desire to be done with her commitment of Office Administrator by May 21, 2020. She will continue working in the position of Financial Secretary. She also Mentioned that our Sjoberg's account has been put on a vacation hold at the parsonage.

Old Business:

Larry informed the council about the meetings the Bishop conducts on Monday mornings through Zoom. There was talk about not only are church's feeling the drop in offering. The Synods tithes are also down 37% and they had to make the choice of suspending 2 weeks of payments to the ELCA. The Bishop covered guidelines for funerals, baptisms and weddings during our shut down and social distancing situation.

Need to check on the situation with Bethel and their contract that they have with us and unable to fulfill. We are being provided a prerecorded sermon to be used at both Moe and Messiah's worship time on the radio by the Bishop for Sunday April 19, 2020.

Bob made a motion to alternate with Moe on a rotating schedule every other week like "the Summer Schedule" until further notice. Seconded by Marty.

In the newsletter there was information describing a challenge for everyone to do for the tin cups! Decorate a tin can, and share it on facebook. This is a way to interact with each other. The tin can challenge is designated for the Pathways Camp Emmaus. Pathways News will be release on May 1st, with the dates and if it will be taking place.

New Business:

Cares Act PPP loan application was filled out by Stu and we qualified for \$24,000. Talked about the loan and decided to have Stu activate in case we need it.

Karen reported that they are waiting for the survey results to determine if we continue with a call committee combined with Moe or just Messiah. The results would be collected after the deadline that the survey was due April 15! They have received a couple prospects and will then follow up with a phone interview.

Karyn made a motion to accept the request of Jay officiating a Wedding for Katie Hager in October. Seconded by Jodie Safety and Security plan is being worked on. Bob will give the updates at the next meeting.

2020 goals are tabled at this time
