1811-1881

Jacob Kremer:

Son of Jacob Kremer and Magdalena Flovin of Montabaur, Nassau Hesse, Germany, was born, April 15 1811, christened at St. Peter's RC Church in ~~Montabaur~~. *Pfarr Weisnach, GER.*

Jacob married, Freidrika Margarethe Raab, daughter of Christian Raab and Marie Eschoenfer of Diez, Germany. They were married on February 12 1839, They had issue:

1849. Jacobs first wife, Fredirika Margarethe Raab , died, Aug 31 1849 in Montabaur and is buried in the Church Cem..

1850 : Jacob remarried on November 10 1850, in the Catholic Church of St. Peter's in ~~Montabaur~~. *Pfarr Weisnach* He married Anna Marie Doktor, daughter of Johann Georg Doktor and his wife, Catherine Scheurr of Koblenz. They had issue: a son, Jacob Kremer, born June 03 1852, in Montabaur.

1852: Jacob and his family announced in the local paper of his intentions to immigrate to the United States. on August 20 1853 "Shoemaker of the town of Montabaur , "W-5430" .

1853 From the book of Germans arriving in America-1853 9061 Page 160 with family. He landed and settled in the German area of the Lower east side of New York City called "Kleindeutschland" or "Little Germany".

1857 Jacob submitted his application to become a citizen in 1857 and was approved , April 19 1859.

1860 The 1860 US Census, dated June 30 1860 18th Division 17th ward Page 174- address 48 First Ave NYC:

- Jacob's second wife Anna Marie Doktor , died August 23 1870 of TB. Their Residence ,408 6th St NYC NYC Certificate # 68742 She was interned in Union Cem. Brooklyn, and then reinterned at the Cedar Ridge Cem in Brooklyn.*
- In the 2nd Enumeration of the 1870 US Census, dated December 1870 shows, Jacob had moved to live with his daughter, "Susanna" Becker on 14th Street, between Catherine and Market St, NYC*
- Jacob Kramer FIL Age 60 Shoemaker- Born Bavaria, Germany*
- 1874 *His son , Jacob, now in the US Army , married "Ellen L. Jackson, , in Bridgeport, CT.*
- 1880 *Now living with his son, Jacob at Fort Slocum, David's Island, New Rochelle, NY*

- 1881 *Jacob Kramer died at 327 Spring St in NYC, the home of his daughter Josephine Baumgart , Oct 25 1881 ,age 70 years 6 months He died of Typhoid Fever , NYC Certificate # 400554 and is interned in Luthern Cem, Middle Village, LI, NY. His daughter in law, Ellen L Jackson Kramer ,is also buried in the same plot., Public 18 Map 18 Grave 38 (No Stone)*
