The Town Board of the Town of Farmington does adopt the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the County Department of Human Services, presently located in the City of Waupaca, is in needof expanding its facilities and the Waupaca County Board of Supervisors is considering all available options,

AND WHEREAS, the City of Waupaca is the County seat and present site of said Departmental offices,

AND WHEREAS, the moving of Department offices to another community would further scatter County offices to the detriment of good and efficient government, according to the East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission Report of September, 1983,

AND WHEREAS, the moving of Department offices to another community would force as many as one hundred (100) employees to move from Waupaca or commute from Waupaca at considerable personal expense,

AND WHEREAS, the majority of cases being handled by the Department are for persons residing within a nine (9) mile radius of the City of Waupaca (1,099 of the total caseload of 2,016 as of December 1, 1986) with twenty-three (23%) percent of all cases originating at the Wisconsin Veterans Home which is located southwest of the City of Waupaca,

AND WHEREAS, the Waupaca County Department of Human Services must interact often times each day with the Sheriff's Department and Circuit Court System both of which are located in the City of Waupaca,

AND WHEREAS, County residents outside the City of Waupaca are presently served well by a toll free calling system, home visits and outreach offices in the Cities of New London and Clintonville.

THEREFORE, it is resolved that in the interest of good and efficient government and controlled government spending that the Town Board of the Town of Farmington recommend that the Waupaca County Board of Supervisors vote to build any needed new facilities for the Waupaca County Department of Human Services in the City of Waupaca.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Chairman shall transmit a copy of this resolution to the Waupaca County Board of Supervisors immediately upon its approval.
