There's Carmen, who was a modern day slave, scavenging a dump for recyclables. She's in school now and brings her 6-year-old brother Byron to schoo study. And are 61 other children whose inspiring stories begin with someone's generosity.

Our Dream to Enable Our Students Dreams

Stability is a key aspect in providing a solution to the wrath of poverty. Through our education center, The Integral Heart Foundation provides educational scholarships for 60 students to receive a compelling education and break out of a viscous cycle of generational poverty.

But most important to their success, they are given love, individual attention, and dependable adults in their life who they can count on. They have someone who they can show their grades who will say, "I'm proud of you."

Older students go through our teacher training course to pass on their wisdom to younger students—Guatemalans solving the problems of Guatemala.



Focused on Finding Funding

Now that our education programs. as well as our meals program are up and running at the Education Center, we are focused on the on-going expenses of maintaining these services.

Our operating costs for 2016 were between \$34,000—that's just 500 Starbucks lattes per month to run the center! We opened the center by raising 20k in onetime donations and are now focused on securing enough sustaining sponsors to run the center into the future.
