Pastoral Letter

One of your concerns these days is the coronavirus (COVID-19) spreading out in the nation. Just a couple of weeks ago, it was a problem only in Asia, Europe, and the Middle East; however, it became our own issue. From west (Washington and California) to east, it took only a few days. As of Saturday evening, there are 417 confirmed cases in 31 states including 1 case in Virginia, and 19 people died. Unfortunately, the number of confirmed cases and the number of deaths will increase much more and much faster than we expected. So far, there has been no vaccine against the coronavirus. Therefore, in order to prevent infection from others, we must wash our hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and try to maintain social distance with less or no physical contact. And if you have a fever, cough, and/or shortness of breath (these symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure), please contact your primary doctor and remain home until you are recovered. From today, NUMC will provide a worship service livestreaming on our Facebook page (and YouTube next Sunday). In addition, I am the one who has the most physical contact with our church members (e.g. hugging and shaking hands). For our public health and safety, please understand that I will greet you with words and nodding instead of shaking hands and hugging. With the experience in Korea, we would have changes in life and in worship Please take care of yourself.
