What is CCS?

A voluntary program for children and adults who have a mental health, substance abuse or co-occurring diagnosis.



What does it provide?

Psychosocial rehabilitation services to children and adults.



Where does it provide these services?

In the community, home, or office.











What kinds of services?

A blend of services, natural support and non-traditional activities in a wraparound model, person-centered model, and recovery oriented manner.

CCS SERVICE ARRAY INCLUDES:

Assessment to determine eligibility and needs.

 -  COMMUNICATION SKILLS TRAINING
 -  EMPLOYMENT SKILLS.
 -  MEDICATION MANAGEMENT.
 -  PHYSICAL HEALTH AND MONITORING.
 -  SYMPTOM MANAGEMENT.
 -  THERAPY
 -  SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT.
