FEATURED SJO MEMBER MUSICIAN – ALICE DAY



Born into the extraordinary musical tradition of gospel, Alice has committed her life to music. Her professional singing career began while still a teenager growing up in Miami. Drawing inspiration from the greats such as Dinah Washington, Billie Holiday and Mahalia Jackson, Alice created her own distinctive style and is acknowledged as one of the finest jazz vocalists performing today. Jazz Entrepreneur, Frank Spina once said of her, "*Alice Day is a renaissance woman. She has the ability to mesmerize and captivate an audience with her stage presence. Whether singing an intimate ballad, or a raucous, belting blues, there ain't nobody does it better.*"

Affectionately known as "*The First Lady of Jazz*", Alice is in demand at top jazz venues around the world and regularly tours in Switzerland, Italy, Germany, France, Austria and Thailand. Her outstanding contribution to music has been honored and she is the recipient of numerous awards including the coveted 'Cultural Ambassadors' Award, and the 'Key to the City of Miami'. In 2009 she was also inducted into the 'South Florida Jazz Hall of Fame' and has gone on to produce the annual event presented each June in Miami, Florida.

To see Alice perform is an enriching experience. It is impossible not to be moved by the depth of feeling she instills into jazz classics – a feat only possible by those who have devoted a life to the genre, an increasingly rare experience. Her approach to more obscure jazz numbers is playful and exploratory. Seldom is a song ever performed in the same way. Tempo and delivery vary according to inclination, nuances are exploited, and the audience is always delighted.

A CANTICLE for TINKER

Guitarist Cyril Benjamin Tinker died Monday, August 20, 2012 at Stony Brook Hospital. He succumbed to chronic renal failure at the age of 69. Tinker was born in the Bahamas on January 4th, 1943. In 1960, as a young man, he moved to Miami where he made his entertainment debut with "The Fish Ray Show". In 1972, he joined the "Joe Donato Band".

I saw saxophonist, Joe Donato, and his featured guitarist, Cyril Benjamin Tinker, perform back then. They did their shtick at the club Le Jardin at the Miami Airways Inn on LeJeune Rd. Donato and Tinker were a smoking hot act that lasted five years. No slouch himself, Donato said "Tinker's 'strum' and musical energy was most powerful and he sure could 'put the pots on' (cook)". At that time, the airport district was a happening place. The Four Bits entertained across the road at the Miami Skyways. The Miami Sound Machine, led by the Estefans, honed their 'Miami Sound' down the street at the Crossroads Hotel.

Jimmy Crawford reined with his piano bar act at Brothers Two. And Pete Minger, Curtis Fuller and Charlie Mingus, expatriates from the Basie All Stars, commanded the bandstand at Lenny Zeif's club at the Travelers Hotel. Even with all this action, you still had to show up early at Le Jardin to squeeze in to see Joe Donato and his perfect foil and fellow musician, the mighty Tinker. After Le Jardin, Tinker's band, "Good Bread Alley", brought him from Florida to the Hamptons. Later, in the early nineties, he assembled a new group of musicians to form "The Starfish Band". He remained in the New York area for the next 20 years where he entertained and delighted audiences from Bellport to Montauk. With his various bands, he played guitar, sang, and wrote many original compositions, recording some on CD.

Sadly, Tinker died a few weeks ago. On Saturday, September 8th, many of his friends gathered to play music and celebrate his life at CAREY-ROYAL-RAM'N Mortuary on NW 7th Ave. in Miami. Following the service, the musicians continued to jam until the wee hours in his memory down the street at Shantel's Lounge. Everywhere he went Tinker's easy manner and infectious smile endeared him to everyone. Rest in peace, Tinker.

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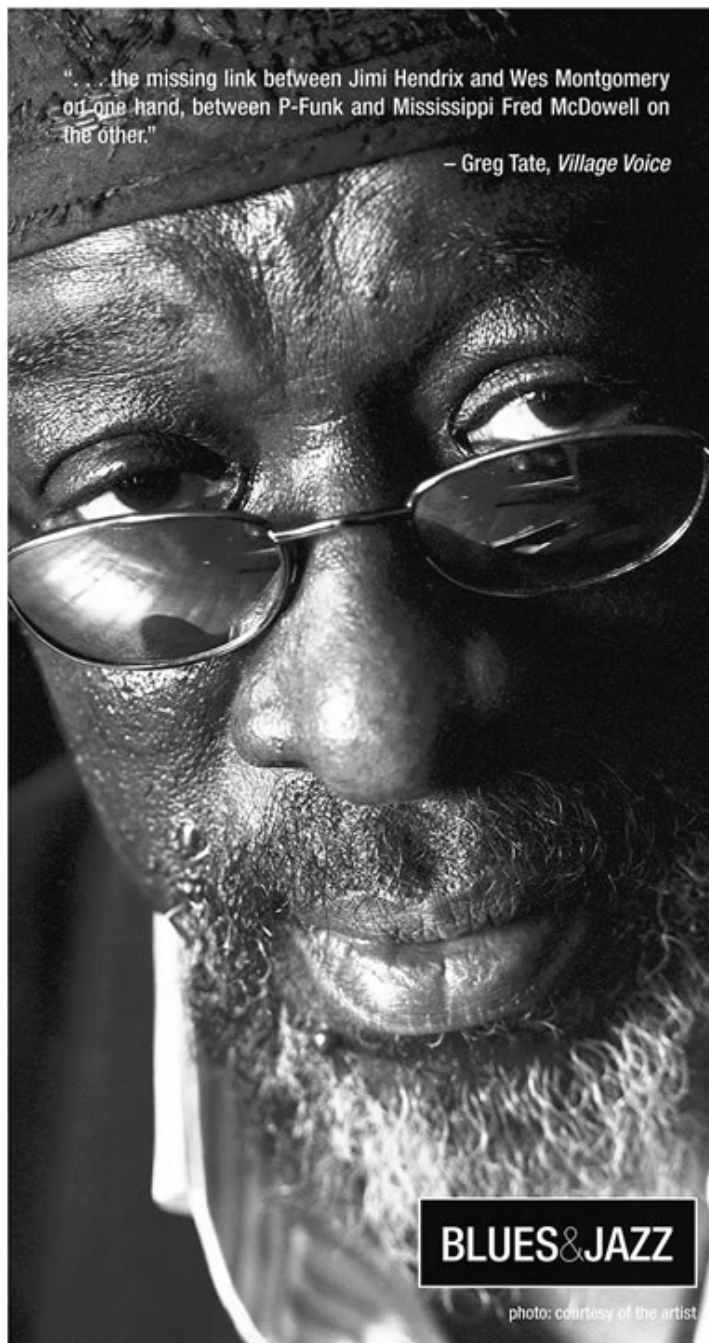
