Child & Adolescent Programs

Welcome to Valley Community Services Board (VCSB). We offer a variety of services for children and families. Our mission is to provide a comprehensive array of behavioral health, substance use, and developmental disability services within the Counties of Augusta and Highland and the cities of Staunton and Waynesboro.

Outpatient Counseling >>>

Outpatient behavioral health individual and group counseling for children, adolescents, and families.

Child Case Management >>>

Assists children and families with accessing services essential to meeting basic needs, linking children and families to needed services and supports

Intensive Care Coordination >>>

Provides intensive case management services to children at risk of an out-of-home placement and/or children already placed in residential settings

Intellectual Disabilities >>>

Services include case management, vocational training, and residential services

School-Based Therapeutic Day Treatment Program >>>

Behavioral health services provided in the school setting for children and adolescents with emotional and behavioral challenges

Substance Abuse Prevention >>>

Classroom-based life skills training programs, school-based therapeutic groups, and Camp Excel (an alternative summer camp for at-risk youth ages 6-17)

Psychiatric Services >>>

Psychiatric services for children, adolescents, and families.

Payment Options >>>

Valley CSB charges fees for our services. We accept most insurances, including Medicaid and Medicare, Anthem/Blue Cross Blue Shield, Coventry, and HealthKeepers. For those without insurance, we offer a sliding scale payment system in order to tailor fees to your specific financial situation. We also offer payment plans to meet individual needs.
