Entries must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow all instructions from Police and Parade officials. The Pageland Watermelon Festival reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade, either prior to assembly, at assembly, or at any time during the parade if the entrant fails to follow parade rules or does not display standards of reasonable public taste as determined by The Pageland Watermelon Festival.

The Pageland Watermelon Festival Board and Staff will have the final authority over positioning of entries in the parade and the pace of the parade. No entry shall delay the forward progress of the parade. The Pageland Chamber of Commerce, Pageland Watermelon Festival, nor the Town of Pageland assume no liability for any damages to any entry.

Parents or other responsible adults (18 or older) must be at the end of the parade route to pick up their children.

All drivers must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance available. These items will be checked before any entry is allowed in the parade at the parade line-up on the day of the parade.

No candy, literature, or other materials may be thrown out along the line of the march. Items may be distributed by walking parade participants.

Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle, or on the person of any participant. Participants consuming alcohol prior to or during the parade will be removed from the line-up, no refunds will be given, and the subjects will not be allowed to participate in any future Pageland Watermelon Festival parades.

All units must reflect a watermelon theme and should have decorations, costumes, and/or music where appropriate.

Agricultural equipment (i.e. tractors) will be allowed to participate in the Pageland Watermelon Festival free of charge.

Rules & Regulations

Personal vehicles, personal motorcycles, personal dirt bikes, personal four wheelers, and other vehicular entries without an official sponsor will not be allowed in the parade. Car Clubs are not considered a sponsor. All entries must contain signage reflecting a sponsor unless the entry is agriculture or antique in design. No animals including horses will be allowed in the parade.

Low speed vehicles (i.e.) golf carts will be allowed as long as they are appropriately decorated and have proper signage.

Homemade and rented floats will be allowed to participate in the Pageland Watermelon Festival free of charge as long as the float meets other regulations. Floats judged unsuitable because of size, safety hazards, or structural weakness will be subject to removal. To ensure the safety of riders, all children must be unloaded from the floats at the end of the parade route.

The parade will be limited. Applications are accepted based on creativity, proposed use of theme, and type of unit.
