BRIAN

Thanks Allegra, you really saved us tonight. Kristen loves when you play Monopoly with her.

ALLEGRA

What goes on in my parents' basement, Mr. Krieger?

BRIAN

Not much. Just a meeting of the neighborhood watch.

ALLEGRA

Without any of the neighbors?

BRIAN

A group of us do the trudge work. Newsletters, e-mails, that kind of stuff.

ALLEGRA

Probably be easier if there was a computer in the basement. It used to be a bomb shelter, you know. That's why it's so quiet down there.

(after a beat)
Are you staring at my piercing Mr.
Krieger?

Allegra slowly parts her lips to reveal the stud in her tongue.

BRIAN

I'm just wondering if that thing gets caught in your food.

ALLEGRA

That's not all you're wondering.



BRIAN

(not biting)

Got me all figured out?

ALLEGRA

Like it's a challenge.

(touches her stud)

I have one more of these. Want to see?

BRIAN

I'll pass.

ALLEGRA

Worried Mrs. Krieger might find out?

BRÍAN

Actually I'm worried about why you're so starved for attention.

ALLEGRA

I get all the attention I can handle.

BRIAN

Where is Derek Barnes tonight? Oh, that's right, he was arrested in Muskego.

Allegra narrows her eyes. She didn't see this coming.

ALLEGRA

How do you know about Derek?

BRIAN

And the meth lab and the Canadian smugglers? Insurance companies have access to a lot of databases, Allegra. If you know where to look, everyone's life is an open book.

ALLEGRA

(steps close to Brian) I wonder how my dad would react if he knew you put your hand up my skirt?

BRIAN

(taps the outdoor lighting fixture with his finger) (MORE)

ALLEGRA
