Pastoral Letter

Since the first confirmed case of COVID-19 was found in South Korea on January 20th, the number of confirmed cases significantly increased for the first one and half months, and Korea once became the country who had the second highest number of confirmed cases in the world. Since the first case was found, the Korean government and the Korean CDC have actively promoted prevention measures, tests, and treatments, and most Korean citizens aggressively followed their guidelines. As a result, as of Saturday, there have been less than 10 confirmed cases for three days and no death for two days, and over 85 percent out of the total confirmed cases were fully recovered. The Korean government perceives the potential threats from the virus, but it decided to partially relieve the social restrictions. So, from today (Sunday), churches can officially reopen and have public worship with some strict regulations. When I watched this news, I ask myself, 'when could we do the same?' You may watch the news that protesters were out on the street and shouted to reopen businesses while masked medical professionals stood against them. I feel it is too early in the midst of ongoing increase of numbers, but on the other hand, I can understand their desperate situation, insisting on reopening by taking risks. I ask you, rather than standing on one side, to pray for both sides.
