Supply List

You can use the pattern pieces in the magazine and make your own copies on Newsprint Paper or you can buy the Newsprint from me for \$3. If you decide to copy the pattern pieces from the magazine follow the instructions on how to copy and cut the pieces.

Sewing machine with $\frac{1}{4}$ in foot and your table insert
Open toe foot – Optional
Extra Bobbin

45 degree rotary cutter with extra blade

Tweezers

Purple Thang or Stiletto

12 in Add a Quarter Ruler

Template Plastic – I will have this for sale for \$1

Flower Head pins

Glue Stick – Water Soluble (UHU or equivalent). I will have some extras for sale for \$1.50

Fabric Glue Pen (Sewline or Fons and Porter)

Scotch Tape

Marking Pencil that removes easily. I use the Clover chalk rollers for marking

Plastic bag for scraps

Good Quality cotton thread 50 or 60 wt (Superior or Aurfil)

70/10 Sharp(Microtex) sewing machine needles

Paper Clips

Embroidery Scissors or Snips

3 Large reclosable plastic bags (Ziploc)

12 in cutting ruler

Cutting Mat

Seam Ripper

Travel Steam Iron and Ironing Surface – Optional. There will be irons you can use but if you want one at your table then bring a small iron

Fabric

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard Dark Blue Batik

$\frac{3}{8}$ yard Grey Batik

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard Turquoise Batik

$\frac{1}{8}$ yard Mottled Dark Blue Batik

$\frac{1}{8}$ yard Medium Blue Batik

$\frac{1}{8}$ yard Light Blue Batik

$\frac{3}{8}$ yard Aqua Batik

$\frac{7}{8}$ yard Backing Fabric

28 in square batting

I have a few kits of the fabric used in the Magazine and my sample for sale. The kits are \$25.

Cutting Instructions

If you bought a kit you can skip the first set of cutting instructions. Just following the Additional Cutting Instructions below.

Before cutting fabric take 3 reclosable plastic bags and label them Unit A, Unit B, and Unit C

From Dark Blue Batik

1 – 5 ½ x 42 in strip – Label and place in bag for Unit A

1 – 1 ½ x 42 in strip

From Grey Batik

1 – 2 ¾ x 42 in strip – Label and place in bag for Unit A

1 – 2 ½ x 42 in strip – Label and place in bag for Unit A

4 – 1 ½ x 42 in strips

From Turquoise Batik

1 – 10 x 42 in strip – Label and place in bag for Unit C

Enough 1 3/8 in wide bias strips to total 75" in length for binding – Place in bag for Unit C

From Mottled Dark Blue Batik

1 – 4 x 42 in strip – Label and place in bag for Unit A

From Medium Blue Batik

2 – 1 ½ x 42 in strips

From Light Blue Batik

1 – 2 ½ x 42 in strip – Label and place in bag for Unit C

1 – 1 ½ x 42 in strip

From Aqua Batik

2 – 5 ½ x 42 in strips – Label and place in bag for Unit A

Additional Cutting Instructions

If you have the instructions in the Magazine follows these instructions instead of the ones in the magazine.

Cut, Stack, label and clip together the following and place in bag for Unit B

From the 1 ½ x 42 in Grey Batik cut

5 – 1 ½ x 5 ¼ in rectangles

5 – 1 ½ x 4 ½ in rectangles

5 – 1 ½ x 3 ½ in rectangles

5 – 1 ½ x 3 in rectangles

From the 1 ½ x 42 in Medium Blue Batik cut

5 – 1 ½ x 5 in rectangles

5 – 1 ½ x 3 ½ in rectangles

From the 1 ½ x 42 in Light Blue Batik cut

5 – 1 ½ x 4 ½ in rectangles

From the 1 ½ x 42 in Dark Blue Batik cut

5 – 1 ½ x 5 ¼ in rectangles
