Matt 28:16-20 (NIV) - <sup>16</sup> Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. <sup>17</sup> When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some <u>doubted</u>. <sup>18</sup> Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
