The William N. Pennington Life Center is thankful to announce we have been able to continue to serve our senior population daily meals through our Meals on Wheels program and the drive-up meal pick up Monday through Friday from 11:00 am – 12:30 pm. We have also had the ability to provide toilet paper, miscellaneous toiletries, food, distilled water, and pet food to our senior community who have been unable to leave their residence or locate these items at the store. To date, we have had the privilege of assisting over 125 seniors with these items and served over 1,000 meals through our drive – up program. Local grocery stores, Walmart and Safeway, have implemented designated shopping days and times to accommodate the senior community as well.

Special Shopping Hours

Walmart:

From March 24 through April 28, Walmart stores will host an hour-long senior shopping event every Tuesday for customers aged 60 and older. This will start one hour before the store opens (6:00 am – 7:00 am). Pharmacies and Vision Centers will also be open during this time.

Safeway:

Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:00 am - 9:00 am.
