1) Lifelong companion:

I had negativity and no emotional support from the father and was all alone.

But I still had dread, I wouldn't feel like this if it was the right thing to do, so I decided to choose life for another, and in the process, I chose life for both parents. The father now thanks me for our child as she is such a huge blessing in both our lives, I have no regrets in keeping her. What are inconveniences compared to blessings, absolutely nothing. We have immeasurable love and joy from our daughter. I really don't know what life would have been like without her.

Whilst these stories may not necessarily involve overt Christian practice, they demonstrate the positive reason to affirm relationships, just as Jesus did.
