Aqua-Tuf is Australia's latest flooring innovation. Combining the best of laminate with the best of vinyl, Aqua-Tuf is the first rigid floating floor product that can be installed throughout the entire home.

Like vinyl flooring, Aqua-Tuf is 100% waterproof, meaning it can be installed in wet areas such as kitchens, bathrooms, and laundries. However, with its rigid core and hard textured vinyl surface layer, Aqua-Tuf looks and performs like a floating timber floor.

Looks and Feels like Real Timber

Aqua-Tuf's hard surface layer looks and feels like real Australian Species and Oak timber. Utilising cutting edge manufacturing technology, the surface layer of each board is finished with a protective film embossed with a textured oak grain, loved by architects and designers.

The Best of Laminate, the Best of Vinyl

Save time and cost on installation

Unlike Aqua-Tuf, the soft structure of vinyl (or LVT) when laid will show bumps or hollow spots in the subfloor. Aqua-Tuf's waterproof core creates a rigid plank that hides imperfections in the surface underneath. Not only does it look better laid, it will save time and money during installation as little subfloor preparation is required.

Designed as a floating floor system, additional cost can be saved as no glue is required during installation, while the waterproof board means no moisture barrier is required underneath.

With a 1.5mm high density noise reduction foam underlay pre-attached, Aqua-Tuf follows the same easy installation process as laminate. Boards can be scored to snap easily, and the floor can be walked upon as soon as it is laid.

Suitable for any environment

Aqua-Tuf boards will not contract or expand with climatic variations as much as other floating floor products, reducing the need for large internal and perimeter expansion gaps. Boards can be cut close to the edge of central objects such as kitchen cabinets and appliances, with flexible caulk used to fill gaps.

Firm Click Lock System


Unlike vinyl flooring, the Aqua-Tuf core is less susceptible to softening and expanding during hot spells, ensuring that the 4 sided locking system will hold firm. The rigidity of Aqua-Tuf provides more stability, while looking as smooth and seamless as timber.

Aqua-Tuf is quick, easy, and cost effective to install, and is even suitable for DIY.

Exciting Range — Including a New Wide Longboard

The colour range encompasses the most popular Australian Species and Oak decors to suit any interior, and the board is finished with a micro-beveled edge to further enhance its natural timber appearance.

Rare in products of this type, Aqua-Tuf is forging new ground with the inclusion of a premium longboard option, suitable for larger installations or where a more modern, robust look is desired.

Depending on various ambient conditions such as humidity, temperature, and moisture ingress, all varieties of flooring materials will experience some degree of expansion and contraction. To avoid damage to the floor, expansion gaps should be left around the edges of rooms and between flooring rafts to accommodate this natural movement of the flooring.

Constructed using the same manufacturing process as our Hybrid flooring, matching Aqua-Tuf accessories are designed to bridge this gap and provide a stylish finish to any flooring project.

Care and Maintenance

Caring for your Aqua-Tuf floor is easy. Vacuum or sweep the floor to remove dirt and debris, and use of a damp mop for regular cleaning is suitable. For preventative care, entrance mats and rugs in high wear areas should be considered, together with felt protectors for furniture and appliance legs.
