Dear brothers and sisters,

Dear brothers and sisters,

Today Jesus returns to his hometown of Nazareth and goes to the synagogue as he did every Shabbat. Being there, he is invited to proclaim the word of God. He is handed the scroll of the prophet Isaiah and reads the passage we heard. Up until now there is nothing particular about these scene; but, what Jesus will say after that is what is amazing: "These words are fulfilled in your hearing". What does that mean? It means that the promise that God has made through so many patriarchs, prophets, kings is being fulfilled in front of them. Imagine, God is answering the prayers of His people and the answer is in front of them. This is the beauty of Christianity; our God is not far away but he is "God-with-us" — Emanuel. So as we start this week, I invite you not to forget that God is answering our prayers as we speak — sometimes the answer is not the one we want or we fail to see it, but it is there. Saint Paul is so sure of this that he says in his Letter to the Romans that everything works for the good of those who love God.

Next week is the Sharing God's Blessings Annual Appeal. I encourage you to listen to it with open hearts. So many of our programs run thank to this Appeal. Also, next weekend Mr. Felipe Santos from Genesis Tours will be back with us to collect the forms and deposit that some of you took and if anyone is interested to go in this pilgrimage, he will have a meeting after the 10:30 AM Mass and after the 12 Noon Mass.

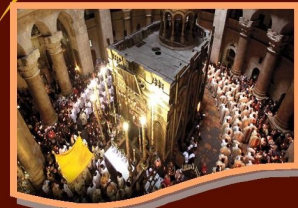

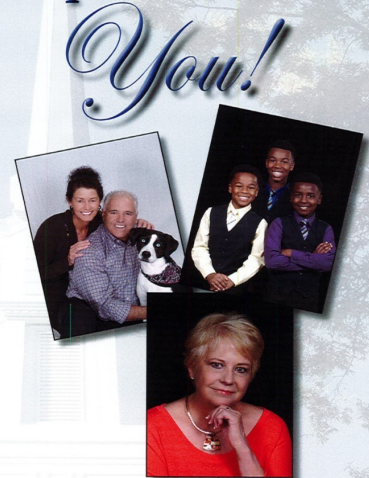
