very person that has ever been born <u>WILL</u> one day answer the question above: either in this life, or at the *judgment*.

Because unlike Why? some ministers and preachers, Jesus "...made himself OF NO REPU-TATION, and took upon him the form of a SER-**VANT**...wherefore God also hath highly exalted him...that at the name of Jesus **EVERY** knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; and that **EVERY** tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (PHILIP. 2:7-11).

Jesus declared, "<u>For God</u> so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten <u>Son</u>" (John 3:16). God Him-

self declared with "... <u>a</u> <u>voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved</u> <u>Son</u>" (MATTHEW 3:17 & 17:5), but the world <u>will not</u> believe God.

Those of us that <u>trust</u> in God <u>KNOW</u> by faith that "...God was <u>IN</u> Christ, reconciling the world unto himself" (2 COR. 5:19), <u>that is</u>, reestablishing a close relationship.

King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon <u>recognized</u> Christ when he cast three Jews into his furnace of fire: "...I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like <u>the Son of God</u>" (DANIEL 3:25-26).

The demons <u>knew who</u> he was when they cried out, "... <u>What have we to</u>

do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of God? art thou come hither to torment us before the time" (MATTHEW 8:29)?

Jesus' disciples <u>knew</u> <u>who</u> he was when Peter said, "...Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the <u>WORDS</u> of eternal life. And we believe and are <u>SURE</u> that thou art that Christ, the <u>Son of the living God</u>" (JOHN 6:66-69).

Yet, when Jesus opened the eyes of the man born blind, the <u>religious leaders</u> said, "...<u>This man is not of God</u>" while others said, "<u>How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles</u>" (JOHN 9:16)?

There is no <u>blindness so</u> <u>dense</u> as <u>religious</u> blindness.

What think YE of Christ?

"...though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is <u>in</u> me, and I in him" (John 10:37-38).
