In the photo from 1948, Southeast looks much as it did when it opened for the first time in 1938. In 1954, a major building project was undertaken as described on the two pages below from the 1954 Crusader. The groundbreaking ceremony for the addition took place on Tuesday, November 10, 1953, although construction had already begun on October 29, 1953. The 1939 Crusader reports that the original building cost \$900,000. Fifteen years later, this 1954 addition cost \$811,128. The addition included 13 new classrooms (west of the library), a swimming pool, a balcony for the auditorium with additional seating for 382, and a gymnasium with seating for 1225 and a movable partition.




