Public Comment

- VLHRC Treasury: Megan the LHRC Secretary presented that VLHRC account now has \$157.98 and several Affiliations have donated to the Valley LHRC for 2014. Megan also presented a ledger to the committee members showing where the money is being spent.
- MR. Collins RETIRING: Chuck Collins announced that he will be retiring March 1, 2015. After retiring he plans to do pro bono guardianship. Chuck plans to attend the January meeting and training. Mark Seymore will be stepping in and taking over for Mr. Collins after he retires. Mr. Collins shared that the department has merged Region one and Region two. Region two will have an advocate that will be supervised by the Region one advocate.
- **Creative Family Solutions Transition to RESCARE:** Diane Procter of Creative Family Solutions shared that the transition to RESCARE is underway. The word is that the Waynesboro office will be relocated to the Charlottesville office but she will still serve the valley. At this time Scott Worley is the active Director.

Affiliate Presentations

- The Arc of Augusta Will present at the January Meeting.
- **Community Living Services:** Will present at the January Meeting.
- **Creative Family Solutions:** Offers In-Home services in our area. At this time they have 23 employees and 12 Individuals. Employees are trained at hire and annually thereafter. They have had no licensing violations this year.

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- Valley CSB: Serves Augusta, Highland, Staunton and Waynesboro. At this time we serve 3,903 Individuals. Abuse/Neglect: 28 cases most cases were medication errors and peer to peer. One case was a sexual allegation which the Individual stated that she had made it up. The police and APS was involved with the investigation. 2 confidentiality allegations that were unfounded. Staff are trained upon hire and annually thereafter. Human Rights are also reviewed annually with the Individual and the poster are posted in their homes.
- Changing Human Rights Posters: Dana Fitzgerald asked a very good question. Who will go on the Human Rights Posters when Chuck retires? Mr. Collins said to add Mark Seymour and for the phone number 1-877-600-7437.
- **CHRIS and the Old Days:** Mr. Collins shared that in the old days when there was a case or concern people would call him to inform him of the situation and they would work on it together. Now with CHRIS he gets around 30 notifications a day and it is just impossible to review them all daily. Mr. Collins asked that if there is something serious going on please contact him to keep him informed because he may not get on CHRIS for a few days.

Affiliation Request:

Blackberry Ridge: Dr. Christopher VonElten Represented Blackberry Ridge. He stated that they will be providing Intensive Outpatient Therapy for addiction to prescription opiates and heroin. This program will be located at Dr. Kanes office and will be group therapy. The groups will be no larger than 7-10 Individuals. They are looking to start in about 6 weeks but depends on Sherry Miles' schedule.

The Committee accepted the Affiliation Request, and the secretary will contact Mr. VonElten with the paperwork he will be responsible for.
