Backgrounds and Beyond

A workshop designed to explore materials like plastic, nappy liners, lutradur, Vlizofix, sizoflor, cellophane, plastic, paper napkins, Crash. Techniques like adding paint with stamps and stencils, heat manipulation, collage and other embellishments. The first day involves creating surfaces to stitch on then the second day is devoted to stitching and decorating these surfaces. A sample work book is the result with lots of new ideas.



One of a Kind Handbag

Now that I have an iPad I needed a safe inconspicuous place to carry it around with me. I couldn't find a suitable handbag with an iPad pocket so I made one!

I took a Belkin laptop pouch with a honeycomb tough outer casing in purple (of course), unpicked all the seams and made it the front and back of my new hand bag. The double zip closure from the pouch allowed me to add it to the back of my bag creating a pocket that open out for my iPad to slip into with out being obvious thats what it's for. The outer fabric is an upholstery chenille print I picked up. I embroidered freehand purple metallic bobbin work onto the front pocket panel to tie it all together. The bag has pockets for all my stuff and false bottom to hide my umbrella underneath.
