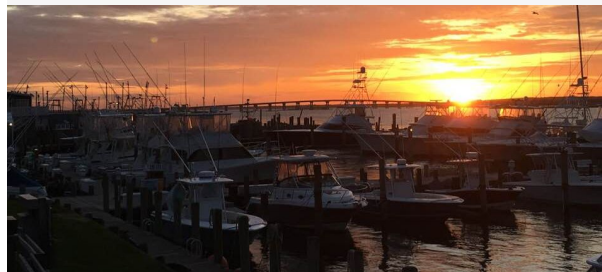

RED LIGHT CAMERAS -- IS THIS REALLY ABOUT

TRAFFIC SAFETY OR IS IT A REVENUE SCAM?

On September 4, 2019 County Legislator Bridget Fleming joined with Democratic colleagues on the Suffolk County Legislature to approve a 5 year-extension of the Red Light Camera Program. The vote was 11-7 along party lines. Republicans on the Legislature voted against the extension, citing safety concerns due to increased accidents documented in a recently commissioned engineering report and that the ticketing program is perceived by the general public as a "money grab." The controversial Red Light Camera "Traffic Safety" Program generates over \$20 Million to the County's General Fund. While this is primarily a "Western Suffolk" issue, from the incumbent County Legislator's line of reasoning that "we need to do everything we can to make Long Island's highways safer" and the "increased fines change behavior so therefore the program is working" - what if the County Legislators try to expand this ticketing scheme to county roads in Southampton and East Hampton?
