LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

I, _____ (sole individual) (hereinafter referred to as "the Client") of _____ (company), appoint Briggamite IRP Services, LLC (hereinafter referred to as "the Provider") my true and lawful Attorney-in-Fact for me, in my name and on my behalf:

- I. To exercise or perform any act, power, duty, right or obligation whatsoever that the Client now has, or may subsequently acquire the legal right power or capacity to exercise or perform, in connection with, arising from or relating to all of the Client's commercial trucking needs.
- II. To represent and serve as a registered agent on matters pertaining to:
 - a. Tags, titles, 2290s, fuel taxes, income taxes, accounting, voluntary revocations, permit applications, intrastate authority, corporation applications, sales and use tax, DOT updating and any other matter the Provider has been hired to complete.
- III. The rights, powers and authority of the Provider as granted in this durable power of attorney shall be commenced and be in full force on the date of this instrument and such rights, powers and authority shall remain in full force and effect thereafter until the Client dissolves this agreement in writing or by phone call.
- IV. The Provider shall be compensated based upon the fee schedule provided upon receipt of INVOICE, and all payments shall be made to the Provider within 5 calendar days of the INVOICE date.
 - a. Should the Client fail to pay the Provider the full amount specified on any INVOICE within 5 calendar days of INVOICE date, the Client understands that a late fee equal to \$_____ shall be added to the amount due.
 - b. By leaving credit card information on file with the Provider, the Client agrees that the Provider may use this information to conduct aforementioned business on the Client's behalf.
 - c. This information and agreement shall remain in full force and effect thereafter until completion of services or until the Client dissolves the agreement either in writing or by phone call.
- V. All actions take by the Provider on behalf of the Client shall be based upon information provided by the Client, and the Provider is hereby indemnified and held harmless by the Client as to the Provider's reliance on any information provided by the Client.
- VI. The Power of Attorney shall continue in full force and effect until revoked by subsequent writing. Further, this Power of Attorney revokes all other Powers of Attorney executed by the Client prior to the date of this Power of Attorney.

This instrument is to be construed and interpreted as a durable Power of Attorney. This durable Power of Attorney shall not be affected by disability of the principal, except as provided by statute.
