Child Care Arrangements

As children are returning to the centre after the virus threat has eased, the centre is starting to fill up again. We have really missed the children and love having many of them back with us.

However, as we no longer receive the full child care subsidy from the Government and no fees from families, we have to carefully budget for our staff and are not able to roster as many casual staff members as previously. As a result, we may need to prioritise children of essential workers and vulnerable children. If this affects your child/ren, we will personally contact you to discuss a suggested change of days.

News from the Office ...

Immunisations

Thank you to everyone who has recently sent through their children's updated immunisation history statements. Please ensure that you email or bring in your children's documentation after each immunisation as we are legally required to keep these statements on file.

Child Care Fees

Under the current government legislation, child care is currently provided free of charge to families until the end of June 2020. At this stage we are expecting the system to revert back to the child care subsidy system from the beginning of July. We will share more information on this as soon as it becomes available.



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Update Family Income Estimate on MyGov for 2020 - 2021

Services Australia has asked eligible families who receive payments from Centrelink, such as Child Care Subsidy (CCS) and Family Tax Benefit (FTB) to provide your family income estimate for the 2020-21 financial year.

You need to do this even though you aren't currently paying child care fees. This is because Centrelink will use this estimate to work out how much CCS and FTB you will get **next financial year**.
