

Students will check in before going to visit their horse.

No Running or screaming in the Barn.

Keep a safe distance from horses.

DO NOT APPROACH an animal without the owner's permission and supervision.

Children under 18 must wear a helmet when mounted.

Giving feed or treats to another person's horse is absolutely prohibited

Horses will be lead with halter and a lead rope at all times.

Clean up after yourself and your horse immediately after use of barn, tack up areas, aisle ways and wash bay.

Student will remain within eyesight of Instructor or camp staff at all times (or check in before going to designated area).

Student will come prepared to learn and have a good attitude

Student agrees to follow directions. If student refuses they may have to sit on the sidelines and watch for part of the activity as it is not safe to ignore directions as they pertain to handling the horses or ponies.

No Cell Phones or other electronics during instruction time.

If parent or guardian is not staying camper does have permission to call them at any time.

(Parent or guardian is welcome to come and stay or drop in at anytime)
