Studio Information and Policies

ATTENDANCE

Good attendance is imperative, as absences and tardiness can hold back an entire class. Students should be prompt and prepared for all classes. Students should login to the Zoom class meeting 5-10 minutes prior to the start time of each class.

MISSED CLASS

A notification by telephone to the school's office is required for missed classes. Please do not email your notification. Please call 202-441-1099 to report an absence.

TARDINESS

Telephone notification to the school is required for tardiness. When late, students must ask the teacher for permission to enter class. It is the teacher's decision whether or not a student can participate in class for the day. Students may be required to observe class and take notes.

INSURANCE

Jones-Haywood Dance School, Inc. does not carry medical insurance for its students. It is required that all students be covered by their own family policies and if injury occurs it is understood that the student's own policy is your only source of reimbursement.

AUTHORIZED USERS

Jones-Haywood will ensure that authorized faculty, staff and Virtual Summer Intensive enrolled students are the sole participants in each Zoom session. Jones-Haywood Dance School, Inc. will take every precaution necessary to ensure that virtual sessions are accessible to authorized users only. Registrants may not forward Zoom links to non-registered participants. If a student or parent is in violation of this policy, she/he immediately forfeits the student's participation in the Jones-Haywood Virtual Summer Intensive and will not receive a refund.

SUMMER INTENSIVE CODE OF CONDUCT

- Students should be dressed in uniform and prepared for class before it begins.
- Space should be pre-set with equipment and materials, and required electronic devices fully charged.
- Students should be on time for each class.
- No food or drinks of any kind are allowed during class.
- Chewing gum is never allowed during class.
- Always treat instructors and fellow dancers with respect.

<u>TUITION</u>

Tuition for the Jones-Haywood Virtual Summer Intensive is \$700 and must be paid in full at the time of registration.

EARLY BIRD TUITION

Tuition for the 1st fifteen (15) students to enroll in the Jones-Haywood Virtual Summer Intensive is \$600. **The deadline for early bird registration is Monday, July 6th.**

TUITION PAYMENT

There are 2 methods of payment:

- 1. Cash App When paying using this method, there is no fee associated with payment.
- 2. Credit Card via Jones-Haywood registration website When paying using this method, there is a 3.7% + \$0.25 processing fee added to tuition, for a total of \$622.45 (early bird) or \$726.15 (regular).

TUITION REIMBURSEMENT

Upon registering, a student has 24 hours to cancel registration, at which time, a full tuition refund will be given. After 24 hours, the right to a refund is forfeited. Tuition reimbursements will not be provided after July 20, 2020 under any circumstances.

PLACEMENT

The level of each student will be determined by the faculty, and is subject to Artistic Director approval. Concerns about placement should be directed to the Artistic Director. Parents should not approach individual faculty members regarding the placement of their child.

CLASS SCHEDULE

The class schedule and/or instructors are subject to change and without notice.

MATERIALS

Required: Laptop or tablet (cell phone is not ideal, but okay); notebook & writing utensil; yoga mat; ballet barre or chair; resistance band

Optional: Bluetooth speaker; wireless headphones; marley

DRESS CODE

In addition to wearing the class-specific attire below, dancers must adhere to the following standards:

- Student's hair must be neat and pulled back into a bun. If hair isn't long enough for a bun, students must secure hair neatly away from the face. Excessive added hair is strongly discouraged, as it can be distracting for the dancer and prohibit certain required movement of the neck and head.
- Uniform must be clean, neat and free of runs, holes and tears.
- Ladies: Hair must be removed from underarms.

Ballet, Floor Barre, Yoga:

Ladies: Flesh tone tights and ballet slippers; black leotard

Gentlemen: Black tights, white t-shirt or leotard, dance belt; black ballet slippers <u>or</u> white socks with white ballet slippers

Modern:

Ladies: Footless black or flesh tone tights and black leotard

Gentlemen: Footless black tights and white t-shirt or leotard; dance belt

Jazz/Contemporary:

Same as modern; jazz shoes

Social Dance & Masterclasses:

Dancers are free to wear dance-appropriate attire of their choice, that reflects the genre of the class.
