Peninsula Piecemakers Logo DESIGN CONTEST 35th Anniversary

The Peninsula Piecemakers Quilt Guild was established in 1985 and the year 2020 will be our 35th anniversary. We want to update our logo design and/or colors and want input from all guild members. New logo designs will be submitted in July 2019 so we can implement the new design for our 2020 year. New pins will be ordered and available in December 2019 or January 2020 when new membership dues are paid. Designs will be voted on by guild members at the August meetings. No change to the current design will be an option for the voting. Ownership of the chosen logo will be exclusive to the Peninsula Piecemakers Quilt Guild. Logo should be adaptable for print and/or electronic use.

The design must be original or a block in the public domain. It should include the name "Peninsula Piecemakers". It should be no more than three (3) colors on a white or black background. The logo should be legible when made into a pin approximately 1" square, circle or rectangle.

Your logo designs submitted should be 5" or 6" square (or 6" diameter if a circle) and be submitted on an 8-1/2" x 11" piece of white unlined paper. Your design can be on a piece of graph paper, but it must be attached to a 8-1/2" x 11" piece of paper. Your design should be in color. Your name, email and phone number should be on the back of the paper.

Logo designs can be submitted on the computer and should be in .jpeg or .png.

Designs should be turned in to Marilyn Rivera by July 15, 2019.

PENINSULA PIECEMAKERS QUILT GUILD 2020 UFO CHALLENGE INFORMATION

Do you need some motivation to complete those UFO's (unfinished objects) that are overtaking your sewing space? Then this is the challenge for you!

Pick six (6) of your UFO's that you want to complete in 2020 and list them with your #1 due in January and the numbers 2-6 in no particular order. Every other month we will pick a number and the corresponding number on your list will be the UFO you will work on. If you bring the completed quilt or garment and show it at Show and Tell in the designated month, your name will be entered in a drawing for some nice prizes to be given in December 2020.

The Executive Board has very generously allocated funds to purchase lots of prizes. But even if you do not win a prize, think of what a winner you will be to have those UFO's finally completed!

FAQ'S

How can I participate?

Answer: Complete two 2020 UFO Challenge forms and give one to us in December and keep the second copy for your records. List your UFO's, 1-6. For each UFO write the name of the quilt or garment and a fairly detailed description of each item (colors, pattern, approximate size, etc.) and what needs to be done to complete each item (add borders, sandwich and quilt, or sew on a label, etc.).

What if I don't have six (6) UFO's?

Answer: Write down as many as you have leaving some numbers blank. The month we draw your "blank number" you can get a head start on another project.

How will I know if my UFO's are acceptable for the challenge?

Answer: When you turn in your form, we will read your completed form and determine if you have enough information.

Can I substitute one UFO for another?

Answer: No; that is why they are numbered and why we have a copy of your list!

How will I know which number to work on?

Answer: The number will be chosen at a guild meeting, will be printed in the next newsletter, and the completed project shown the following month. For example, your number one (1) will be due in January.

Remaining numbers will be drawn and announced in the newsletter every other month.

What if I cannot come to the meeting to show my project?

Answer: The quilt or garment <u>MUST</u> be shown in the designated month. So if you cannot be there, find someone to show it for you.

How do I know if my UFO is complete?

Answer: A completed project means no additional work is needed to display, use, or wear the item.

On the day the completed UFO is due, what do I do?

Answer: Bring the completed project to the UFO Challenge table at the Day or Night Guild Meeting; get checked off; put your name in for the December 2020 drawing; show project at Show and Tell.

We hope you will join us in this fun challenge for 2020!
