

# Who am I?

## Bible Game

### Instructions

- Print out bible character clue cards and backings.
- Cut out the cards and backing with a pair of scissors.
- Glue the “Who am I?” logo to the back of the character card.

**\*Another Option: For longer lasting cards laminate or print out on card stock\***

### How to Play

- **Objective:** To guess the bible character correctly by the clues given on the cards.
- Start the game by shuffling the cards.
- Decide who will go first.
- The first player to read the cards will start by reading the first clue. He/she will continue to the fifth clue or until the character has been guessed correctly.
- The first person to guess the bible character correctly wins that round.
- Only one guess per person should be allowed per round.
- Once the round is finished, the player to the right of the first reader, reads the next card.
- The game is over when there are no more cards left or when everyone decides to finish the game.
- The point of the game is not to have a winner, but have fun and learn more about the bible and the characters in it.

**Note:** Cards with a red **K** in the upper right hand corner are kings of the bible. If you would like to have a separate game consisting of the Kings of Judah and Israel use these cards only.

1. Was a chief tax collector
2. Lived in Jericho
3. Was a rich man
4. Gave half his possessions to the poor
5. Climbed up a Sycamore tree to see Yahshua

## ZACHARIAH

1. Spoke with a cherub of Yahweh
2. Was a priest in the days of Herod
3. Was an older man
4. Could not speak for many months
5. His son was called Prophet of the Most High

He beat out wheat in a winepress to hide it from the eyes of Midian

## AHAZ



1. Took silver and gold out of the House of Yahweh and sent it to the king of Assyria as a bribe
2. Burned incense offerings to pagan gods and sacrificed his own children through fire
3. Reigned 16 years as king starting at age 20
4. Was the 12th king of Judah
5. One of the most evil kings of Judah

## HEZEKIAH



1. Opened the doors of the House of Yahweh and repaired them in the first year of his reign
2. Showed the rulers of Babylon all the house of his treasury
3. Beat to bits the bronze serpent that Moses made in the wilderness
4. Given a sign by Yahweh
5. 13th King of Judah

## BALAAM

1. Lived in the city of Pethor in Mesopotamia
2. Counseled with Israel's enemies, leading Israel astray
3. Son of Beor
4. Was saved by his donkey
5. Blessed the sons of Israel instead of cursing

## BALAK

1. Son of Zippor
2. Built seven altars in three different places
3. Threw a stumbling block before the sons of Israel
4. King of Moab
5. Sent messengers to Balaam

## RAHAB

1. Received messengers and sent them out by another way
2. Heard all that Yahweh did from a distant land
3. Let two men down by a rope from her window
4. A harlot woman
5. Binded a scarlet thread of line in her window

## EHUD

1. Son of Gera, from the tribe of Benjamin
2. Had a crippled right hand

1. Husband died
2. Had a sister-in-law

4. Lived in the fields of Moab
5. Kissed her Mother-in-law and turned back

## **BOAZ**

1. Lived in Bethlehem
2. Spent the night in a threshing floor
3. Had compassion on a young foreign woman
4. Raised up the name of him who died over his inheritance
5. Great grandfather of a famous king

## **EZRA**

1. The son of Seraiah
2. Called a fast at the river Ahava
3. Skilled scribe in the Torah of Moses
4. Was given a letter by king Artaxerxes
5. Came up to Jerusalem from Babyon

## **NEHEMIAH**

1. The son of Hachaliah
2. Was a cupbearer to a king
3. Threatened merchants camping outside the city on the Sabbath
4. Governor of Jerusalem
5. Rebuilt the wall around Jerusalem

## **BALAAM'S DONKEY**

1. Saw a Messenger of Yahweh standing in the road

5. Servant of a Patriarch

## BATHSHEBA

1. Daughter of Eliam
2. First son died
3. Husband was murdered within a battle
4. Mother of a famous king
5. Committed adultery against her husband

## JETHRO

1. Was a shepherd
2. Brought a man's wife and sons to him
3. Rejoiced regarding all the good which Yahweh had for the son's of Israel
4. Gave the idea of judges throughout the Israel camp
5. Priest of Midian

## NABAL

1. Very wealthy and lived in Maon
2. Was a Calebite, cruel and evil in his dealings
3. Returned evil for good to a man asking of welfare
4. Heart turned to stone and died within after hearing of his evil
5. Was stricken by Yahweh and died after ten days

## URIAH

the Hittite

1. Died in battle while laying siege against Rabah
2. Laid down at the entrance of a king's house
3. Was a righteous and faithful servant to his service for the king
4. Delivered a letter sealing his fate

1. Struck and killed a man
2. Held his hands up to prevail over his enemies in battle
3. Took advice from his father-in-law

## JOSHUA

1. Was full of the spirit of wisdom
2. Was buried in Timnath-Serah, within the hills of Ephraim

## OBADIAH

1. Greatly feared Yahweh
2. Name means "Servant of Yahweh"
3. A prophet during the days of King Ahab
4. A prophet to Edom
5. Hid 100 prophets, 50 in each cave

## MORDECAI

1. Was second in the kingdom and great among the Jews
2. The son of Jair, a Benjamite
3. Wrote a law turning back an evil decree against his people
4. Took care of his cousin
5. Rode around the city in royal garments and on a royal horse

## KING AHASUERUS

1. Reigned over 127 provinces
2. Lived in Shushan the palace
3. Put away his own wife
4. Held out a golden scepter to save a life
5. King of the Persians and the Medes

## HAMAN

1. Son of Hammedatha the Agagite
2. Received a ring from a king
3. Was raised to a seat above all the rulers in the kingdom
4. Was hanged
5. Sought to destroy all the Jews in the kingdom of Persia

## ZADOK

the Prophet

1. Son of Ahitub
2. Was a priest

1. An Archite and friend to David
2. Remained in Jerusalem when David fled from Absalom
3. Broke down the counsel of Ahithophel the king's counselor
4. Deceived Absalom and helped David
5. Reported to Zadok and Abiathar all that Absalom was to do

## MIRIAM

1. A prophetess
2. Had two brothers
3. Got leprosy for seven days
4. Died in the wilderness of Zin
5. Danced and sang before Yahweh with a timbrel

## NAAMAN

1. Commander of the army of Syria
2. Went before Elisha the prophet
3. Had leprosy
4. Paid Gehazi for his cleansing
5. Washed in the Jordan seven times

## ISAIAH

1. Had a son named Maher-Shalal-hash-baz
2. Was touched on the mouth by a hot coal from a seraph
3. Prophet during the reign of four kings of Judah
4. Son of Amoz
5. Prophesied the sign to King Hezekiah extending his life by 15 years

## JEREMIAH

1. Was from the city of Anathoth in the land of Benjamin
2. Was drawn out of a pit by an Ethiopian Eunuch
3. Was sanctified and appointed a prophet while in his mother's womb
4. Bought a field from his uncle for 27 shekels of silver
5. Prophet during the last kings of Judah

## NAOMI

1. Had a spouse that died
2. Was from Bethlehem
3. Had a mighty kinsman
4. Had a faithful daughter-in-law
5. Was a nurse to David's grandfather

## SOLOMON

1. Very wealthy, rich and wise
2. Yahweh appeared to him in a dream
3. Took many foreign wives
4. Reigned 40 years as a king
5. Built the temple of Yahweh

## ABSALOM

1. Killed his brother
2. Lived in Geshur for three years
3. Set Joab's barley field on fire
4. Tried to kill his father and take the throne
5. Hair caught in a great oak while riding on a mule

## DAVID

1. A mighty warrior, skillful in speech
2. His sons were priests
3. Died at an old age
4. The sword was against his house continually
5. Played an instrument and wrote the Psalms

## JESSE

Father of David

1. An Ephrathite of Bethlemlen Judah
2. Attend a sacrifice with Samuel
3. Father of eight sons
4. Grandson of Ruth
5. Was a shoot coming from a stump

## JEZEBEL

1. Conspired against a man and took possession of his property
2. Threatened the life of a great prophet
3. Child of Ethbaal, King of the Sidonians
4. Cut off the prophets of Yahweh
5. Was thrown from a window and trampled by horses

## GOLIATH

1. Was killed by his own sword
2. Reproached the armies of Israel
3. A Philistine from Gath
4. His height was 6 cubits and a span
5. Fought a famous battle in the Valley of Elah

## JOAB

1. Son of Zeruah
2. Was killed in the tabernacle of Yahweh
3. Received a letter by the hand of a Hittite
4. The general of a great army
5. Loyal servant to David till his death

## SAMUEL

1. Grew both in stature and in goodness both with Yahweh and his men
2. Judged Israel all the days of his life
3. Was called by Yahweh three times
4. Anointed two famous kings
5. Was buried in his house in Ramah where he died

## HANNAH

1. Vowed a vow to Yahweh
2. Was accused of being drunk
3. Lived in Ramah
4. Wife of Elkanah
5. Conceived and bore a son dedicated to Yahweh

## MEPHIBOSHETH

1. From the tribe of Benjamin
2. Ate bread at the table of David continually
3. Was deceived by his servant Ziba
4. Fell and became crippled at age 5
5. Son of Jonathan

## JONATHAN

1. Stood by his father's side always, even until death
2. From the tribe of Benjamin
3. Ate honey not knowing his father said not to
4. Cut a covenant with David
5. Died on Mount Gilboa

## PEKAHIAH



1. Assassinated by a general in his own army
2. Killed in the high place in the house of the king in Samaria
3. Reigned two years
4. 17th king of the Northern Kingdom
5. Son of King Menahem

## SAUL



1. Disobeyed Yaweh twice
2. Took a shepherd from the field to become his armor bearer
3. Taller than any of the people from his shoulder upward
4. The spirit of adversity would depart from him at the sound of an instrument
5. Died the same day as three of his sons

## PEKAH



1. During his reign, the king of Assyria came against him and removed lots of people to Assyria
2. Reigned 20 years in Samaria
3. Was an army general
4. The 18th king over the Northern Kingdom
5. Assassinated by Hoshea

## HOSHEA



1. Was a servant and paid tribute to Shalmaneser King of Assyria
2. Son of Elah and did evil in the eyes of Yahweh
3. During his reign the king of Assyria came against the Northern Kingdom and removed it to Assyria
4. Reigned 9 years in Samaria
5. Final king over the Northern Kingdom

## ISHBOSHETH



1. Was killed by his servants in the bed of his own house
2. Had no son after him to reign
3. Gave back David's first wife to him
4. Reigned 2 years starting at age 40
5. Son of King Saul

## ABNER

1. Cousin of King Saul
2. Made a covenant with David to bring all of Israel under David's reign
3. Was killed by Joab in Hebron
4. Son of Ner
5. Commander of Saul's army

## JEHOAHAZ *H*

1. His army was reduced to 50 horsemen, 10 chariots and 10,000 footmen
2. Did not turn aside from the sins of the house of Jeroboam
3. Sought the face of Yahweh when the kingdom was being given into the hands of Syria
4. Eleventh king of the Northern Kingdom and reigned for 17 years
5. Son of King Jehu

## JEHOASH *H*

1. Captured king of Judah in Beth-Shemesh and took him to Jerusalem
2. Took all the gold, silver and vessels in the house of the Elohim in Jerusalem
3. Prophesied by Elisha that he would have 3 victorious battles over Syria
4. 12th king of Israel and reigned 16 years
5. The son of Jehoahaz

## JEROBOAM II *H*

1. Restored the border of Israel from the entering in of Hamath to the sea of the Arabah
2. Second king of Israel to reign with this name
3. Third generation of Jehu to sit on the throne
4. 13th king over the Northern Kingdom
5. Longest king to reign over the Northern Kingdom at 41 years

## ZECHARIAH *H*

1. Did evil in the eyes of Yahweh as his fathers did
2. Was struck by Shallum and killed before the people
3. Fourth generation of Jehu to sit on the throne
4. 14th king to reign over the Northern Kingdom
5. Reigned only 6 months

## SHALLUM *H*

1. Killed King Zechariah and reigned in his place
2. The son of Jabesh
3. Was assassinated by Menahem
4. 15th king to reign over the Northern Kingdom
5. Reigned one month in Samaria

## MENAHEM *H*

1. Paid off the king of Assyria by taxing wealthy Israelites
2. Son of Gadi and his name means "Comforter"
3. Ripped up all the pregnant women from Tiphah to Tirzah
4. 16th king over the Northern Kingdom and reigned for ten years
5. His son Pekahiah took the throne after he died

## TIBNI



1. The son of Ginath
2. His death was recorded, but not explained
3. Half of the people chose him as king and the other half wanted Omri
4. A civil war broke out between the people of Israel and Omri won
5. Not much is written about this king of the Northern Kingdom

## OMRI



1. Bought the hill of Samaria with two talents of silver
2. Worse than any of the kings of Israel before his reign
3. Did evil in the eyes of Yahweh and caused the people to sin
4. Sixth king of the Northern Kingdom and reigned for 12 years
5. Father of King Ahab

## AHAB



1. Wife was the daughter of Ethbaal, king of the Sidonians
2. Disguised as a soldier, was killed by a stray arrow in the battle against king of Syria
3. Was challenged by the prophet Elijah on Mount Carmel
4. Seventh king of the Northern Kingdom and reigned for 22 years
5. Took possession of Naboth's vineyard

## AHAZIAH



1. Had no son to take over his reign after he died
2. Sent messengers to the pagan temple in Ekron instead of asking Yahweh about his health
3. Fell through the lattice-work in his upper room in Samaria
4. Eighth king of the Northern Kingdom and reigned for 2 years
5. Son of Ahab and Jezebel

## JEHORAM



1. Was wounded in Ramoth Gilead against the Syrians
2. Allied himself with the king of Judah against the Moabite rebellion
3. Son of Ahab and Jezebel
4. Ninth king of the Northern Kingdom and reigned for 12 years
5. Tracked down and killed by Jehu

## JEHU



1. Killed both the king of Judah and king of Israel
2. Killed the whole house of Ahab
3. Was anointed by Elisha the prophet
4. Tenth king of the Northern Kingdom and reigned for 28 years
5. Converted the house of Baal into an outhouse

## ZEDEKIAH *H*

1. Appointed by the king of Babylon, but rebelled against him
2. Refused to accept the counsel of Jeremiah
3. Forced to watch his sons killed, then blinded and taken to Babylon
4. Name was changed from Mattaniah by the king of Babylon
5. He was the last king of Judah

## JEROBOAM *H*

1. Made priests of high places from the lowest of the people
2. Was afraid of the people turning back to the House of David if they went to Jerusalem to sacrifice
3. Fled to Egypt to Shishak, King of Egypt during Solomon's reign
4. His hand withered at the altar in Bethel
5. Given ten tribes to rule over as a king

## NADAB *H*

1. Laid siege against the Philistine city of Gibeon
2. Did evil in the eyes of Yahweh and walked in the way of his father
3. Reigned for 2 years
4. Was assassinated by Baasha
5. His father was the first king of the Northern Kingdom

## BAASHA *H*

1. Was from the tribe of Issachar
2. Struck all the house of Jeroboam
3. Reigned over the Northern Kingdom in Tirzah for 24 years
4. His son Elah took the throne after he died
5. He was the 3rd king of the Northern Kingdom

## ELAH *H*

1. Was killed while drinking himself drunk in the house of Arza
2. Assassinated by his own captain of half the chariots
3. Reigned for 2 years
4. Fourth king of the Northern Kingdom
5. Son of King Baasha

## ZIMRI *H*

1. Struck the whole house of Baasha
2. Set his own house on fire and died in the flames
3. Did evil in the eyes of Yahweh and caused the people of Israel to sin
4. Fifth king of the Northern Kingdom
5. Reigned for only 7 days

## MANASSEH *H*

1. Captured with hooks, bound with bronze fetters and forced into Babylon
2. Built altars for all the host of heaven in two courts of House of Yahweh
3. Repented to Yahweh for his evil and was restored to the kingdom
4. Reigned the longest of all the kings - 55 years
5. 14th king of Judah

## AMON *H*

1. Forsook Yahweh and did not walk in His ways
2. Buried in the Garden of Uzza
3. Reigned two years starting at age 22
4. Servants conspired against him and killed him in his own house
5. Fathered King Josiah

## JOSIAH *H*

1. Burned bones on the altar Jeroboam set up in Bethel
2. Was killed in Megiddo by Pharaoh Neco, King of Egypt
3. He had 3 sons to take the throne after him
4. He performed the greatest Passover ceremony since the days of the judges
5. Reigned 31 years starting at age 8

## JEHOAHAZ *H*

1. Removed as king by Pharaoh Neco
2. Only reigned for 3 months
3. He was taken into Egypt and he died there
4. Name means "Yah has held firmly"
5. He was the son of Josiah

## JEHOIAKIM *H*

1. Surrendered to the king of Babylon and paid him tribute for 3 years
2. Made king by Pharaoh Neco in place of his brother
3. He was the son of Josiah
4. Reigned 11 years starting at age 25
5. Name was changed from Eliakim by the Pharaoh of Egypt

## JEHOIACHIN *H*

1. Was treated as a royal hostage receiving daily rations from the king of Babylon
2. Did evil in the eyes of Yahweh
3. Son of Eliakim
4. Reigned for 3 months starting at age 18
5. He was exciled to Babylon

## UZZIAH



1. Had many cattle and dug many wells
2. Produced war machines, invented to shoot arrows and huge stones
3. Also known as Azariah
4. Reigned 52 years starting at age 16
5. Burned incense upon the altar of Yahweh and got leprosy until the day of his death

## JOTHAM



1. Built the upper gate of the House of Yahweh and much in the wall of Ophel
2. Made himself strong preparing his ways before Yahweh, his Elohim
3. Reigned 16 years starting at the age of 25
4. Eleventh king of Judah
5. Name means "May Yah complete"

## ESTHER

1. Father was Abihail
2. Was brought up by a cousin
3. Fasted 3 days and 3 nights
4. Name was changed to hide their identity
5. Spouse was a famous king in Persia

## ABIMELECH

1. Was born in Shechem
2. Ruled over Israel for 3 years
3. Son of Jerubbaal
4. He went to his father's house and killed his 70 brothers
5. A woman threw a millstone on his head and crushed his skull

## MANOAH

1. Spoke face to face with The Messenger of Yahweh
2. From the tribe of Dan
3. Wife was barren
4. Ate honey from a body of a lion
5. His son was known for his physical strength

## DELILAH

1. From the valley of Sorek
2. Was lied to three times
3. Hired by philistine rulers
4. Said "The Philistines are upon you!"
5. Rewarded 1100 pieces of silver for her deception

## ATHALIAH *H*

1. Both mother and father were from the Northern Kingdom
2. Seized power and killed all members of the royal family of Judah, except one
3. Ripped clothes and yelled "Treason!"
4. Commanded to be taken out of the temple by Jehoiada the priest
5. Executed in the King's palace near the Horse Gate

## JEHOSHAPHAT *H*

1. Sent priests and Levites all over the country to teach the Law of Yahweh
2. Built fortresses and supply centers throughout Judah
3. Allied with King Ahab to fight against Judah
4. Fourth King of Judah
5. Name means "Yah is judged"

## JEHORAM *H*

1. Killed all his brothers and the leaders of Israel
2. Married a daughter of the King of Israel
3. Constructed idol shrines in Judah and compelled his people to worship them
4. Fifth King of Judah
5. He got bowel disease

## AHAZIAH *H*

1. Had no son to take over his reign after he died
2. Sent messengers to the pagan temple in Ekron instead of asking Yahweh about his health
3. Fell through the lattice-work in his upper room in Samaria
4. Eighth king of Israel and reigned 2 years
5. Son of Ahab and Jezebel

## JOASH *H*

1. Assassinated by own officials while in his bed
2. Proclaimed rightful ruler by Jehoiada the Priest
