Bible Story Time

The Passover Lamb

Exodus 12:1-27

And YAHWEH said to Moses and to Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, This month *shall be* the head of months for you. It *shall be* the first of the months of the year for you. Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying, On the tenth of this month, they shall each take for themselves an animal of the flock for a father's house, a flock animal for a house. And if the house is too small for a flock animal, he and his neighbor next to his house shall take according to the number of souls, each one according to the mouth of his eating, you shall count concerning the flock animal.

A flock animal, a male without blemish, a yearling, shall be to you. You shall take from the sheep or from the goats. And it shall be for you to keep until the fourteenth day of this month. And all the assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it between the evenings.

And they shall take from the blood, and put *it* on the two side doorposts and on the upper doorpost, on the houses *in* which they eat it



And they shall eat the flesh in this night, roasted with fire, and they shall eat it with unleavened *bread* and bitter herbs. Do not eat it raw, or at all boiled in water, but roasted with fire; its head with its legs and with its inward parts. And you shall not leave any of it until morning. And you shall burn with fire that left from it until morning. And you shall eat it this way: *with* your loins girded, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. And you shall eat it in awe. It *is the* Passover to YAHWEH.

And I will pass through in the land of Egypt in this night. And I will strike every first-born in the land of Egypt, from man even to livestock. And I will execute judgments on all the Elohe of Egypt. I *am* YAHWEH!

And the blood shall be a sign to you, on the houses where you *are*. And I will see the blood, and I will pass over you. And the plague shall not be on you to destroy, when I strike in the land of Egypt. And the day shall be a memorial for you. And you shall celebrate it *as* a feast to YAHWEH, for your generations. You shall celebrate it *as* a law forever.

You shall eat unleavened *bread* seven days. Indeed, on the first day you shall cause leaven to cease from your houses. For anyone eating any leaven, that soul shall be cut off from Israel, from the first day until the seventh day.

And on the first day *shall be* a holy assembly, and in the seventh day a holy assembly, shall be to you. Not any work may be done on them. Only what must be eaten by each soul that alone may be done by you. And you shall observe the unleavened *bread* for on this very day I brought out your armies from the land of Egypt. And you shall observe this day for your generations, a statute forever.

In the first *month*, on the fourteenth day of the month, at evening you shall eat unleavened *bread*, until the twenty-first day of the month, at evening. *For* seven days no leaven shall be found in your houses. For anyone eating *any* leaven, that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, among the foreigners, and among the natives of the land. You shall not eat anything leaven. You shall eat unleavened *bread* in all your dwellings.

And Moses called to all the elders of Israel and said to them, Draw out And take a bunch of hyssop and dip in the blood in the basin. And touch some of the blood in the basin to the lintel and on the two doorposts. And you shall not go out, anyone from the door of his house until morning.

And YAHWEH will pass through to strike Egypt. And He will see the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, and YAHWEH will pass over the door. And He will not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you.


And you shall observe this Word for an ordinance for you, and for your sons forever. And it shall be, when you come into the land which YAHWEH shall give to you, as He has spoken, you shall observe this service. And it shall be, when your sons say to you, What *is* this service to you?

Then you shall say, A sacrifice of a passover of YAHWEH, who passed over the houses of the sons of Israel in Egypt when He struck Egypt. And He delivered our houses. And the people bowed and worshiped.

Bible Story Questions

- 1. What is the first month of the year?
- 2. What were the Israelites commanded to take on the 10th of the month of Aviv?
- 3. What were they supposed to do on the 14th of Aviv?
- 4. Were they allowed to leave any of the lamb until morning?
- 5. What was going to happen to all the firstborn whose houses did not have any blood on the night of the 14th?
- 6. What did Yahweh do for the Israelites on the 15th of Aviv?
- 7. How many days are we supposed to keep the Feast of Unleavened?
- 8. Why do we keep the Passover?

Bible Lesson: Our Passover is Messiah

The Israelites were commanded by Yahweh to choose a lamb that they would later have to kill so that their firstborn would live.

On the 14th day of Aviv, after sunset and before it got very dark, they would kill the lambs and take their blood and put it on the doorposts of their houses. Then in the middle of the night, the death angel would pass over their houses because of the blood of the lambs. This was so important that Yahweh didn't want them to ever forget what He did for them in Egypt so He made sure that at every Passover, they would teach their children what Passover is all about.

Every believer who joins the New Covenant when they are baptized and have hands laid on them by an elder become a firstborn to Yahweh. Every firstborn believer has sinned and the punishment for their sin is death. However, Yahweh sent Yahshua to be our Passover lamb and by Him dying and shedding His blood, He has wiped away all our sins.

Just like Yahweh saved the Israelites from the bondage of Egypt, He saves us today from the bondage of sin. Then clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are unleavened. For our Passover is Messiah who was sacrificed for our sake (1 Cor. 5:7).
