NEW BUSINESS

Graduation: Tuesday, June 14 at 3:00 pm.

Kids will need to bring a change of clothes because we will collect all concert uniforms immediately after return from graduation ceremony. Goal is to have uniforms cleaned and returned by July 1 so it is on this year's budget vs. next.

We will need to rent a U-Haul to move percussion instruments to Siegel Center for graduation. There is a back loading entrance. No chaperones are needed for this event. We will need 2 to 3 parents to help unload and drive the U-Haul.

Next Year's Budget
