VISIT OF THE RELICS OF ST. BERNADETTE

The Bishops of England & Wales will welcome a pilgrimage of the relics of Saint Bernadette of Lourdes in September and October next year. Precise dates of the diocesan stage of the pilgrimage are still to be confirmed and information will be made available in due course. This will provide a wonderful opportunity for prayer for the whole Diocese and, given the significance of our Lourdes Pilgrimage in the life of the Diocese, will be a time of particular joy for us all.

COVID-19 VIRUS - OMICRON VARIANT

With respect to the current situation with the Omicron variant it is important to ensure the following points are followed in our churches:

- That people displaying any symptoms of Covid-19 should stay at home and not travel to church or participate in person.
- That hand sanitiser is available to those attending the church.
- From Friday 10th December, it will be compulsory for people to wear a face covering (both nose and mouth) whilst indoors in public venues including places of worship.
- That there is good ventilation and air throughout in the building; in this case, because of climatic conditions, it would be important to remind people to wrap up well in church!
- That a positive message encouraging people to get vaccinated and have the booster jab when able is delivered whenever possible.
- That people who are engaged in a form of pastoral ministry which involves ministry to the housebound, sick and vulnerable, should take regular lateral flow tests to ensure they are safe to do so. These are free from the NHS.

There is now very strong evidence to support that the main mode of transmission is through breath and nasal aerosols, and that the risk from surface and touch transmission is very small indeed. As such, the strict regimes of church cleaning that were recommended at the beginning of the opening of churches for public worship are no longer necessary. General church cleaning is sufficient.

If these guidance points are supported, then churches will continue to be safe places for people to gather for acts of public worship, including over the Christmas period.

JUSTICE & PEACE ASSEMBLY 2022 WEBINAR

A webinar on '*To a safer shore*?' from 10am-1pm on **Saturday 15th January 2022**. This year's event focuses on the considerable difficulties and challenges faced by individuals and families of all ages who are compelled to leave their homes and seek safety - and longed for sanctuary - in countries that can be considerable distances from their homes.

Speakers include **Aidan Cantwell**, from the <u>Jesuit Refugee Service</u> who will explore current legislation in the UK and how best we can respond, **Karen Goldsmith**, who has first-hand experience of the refugee crisis, having spent time volunteering at a refugee camp in <u>Chios</u>, <u>Greece</u>, **Canon Rob Esdaile** who will provide insight on <u>Pope Francis' Encyclical Fratelli Tutti</u> and **John Paul de Quay**, from the <u>Ecological Conversion</u> <u>Group</u>, who will examine the links between the plight of refugees and climate crisis.
