Responsorial Psalm – [Psalm 40](#): “Lord, come to my aid!”

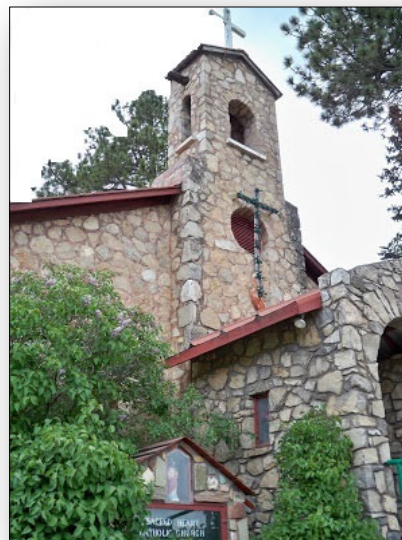
Second Reading – [Hebrews 12:1-4](#): “Consider how he endured such opposition from sinners, in order that you may not grow weary and lose heart.”

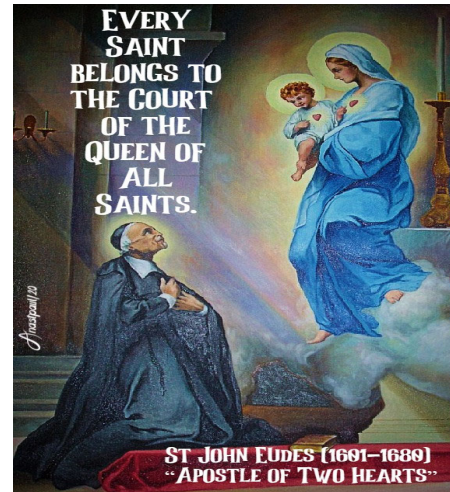
