



2021 GLDC Medals Program

Awards:

Bronze, Silver, and Gold Medals

Award Classifications:

Junior – A person who is 21 years old or younger within the award year.

Amateur – A person who is 22 years and older within the award year and who engages in dressage for the pleasure of it rather than for money. An amateur may not accept payment (remuneration) in any form such as cash, goods, discounts or services, or in-kind exchange of goods and services such as boarding or training. Amateurs may not take remuneration for riding, exercising, showing, training, assisting in training, schooling, conducting clinics or seminars aside from incurred expenses.

Open – Classification for a person not eligible as a Junior or Amateur.

Qualifications:

An individual is to be a GLDC member, in good standing, at the time the scores are earned.

Scores are accumulative starting in 2016 and not limited to one year.

An individual must ride in a GLDC-affiliated clinic or show; volunteer at an affiliated event; sponsor a GLDC schooling show class; instruct one or more students during a GLDC schooling show the year of the award; or attend 4 GLDC monthly meetings this year.

A medal is awarded to a horse and rider combination.

A horse and rider combination is limited to one medal per year per discipline. A horse and rider combination may participate and earn a bronze, silver, and gold medal in both English and Western disciplines.

A horse and rider combination is limited to one bronze, one silver, and one gold per discipline.

Scores must be mailed to the Sarah Kreuz by Oct. 7th.

The Medals Awards will be presented at the GLDC annual awards dinner.

Scores:

Three (3) submitted tests are to come from two (2) different shows and two (2) different judges.

One score must come from the highest test of the level.

Schooling and/or recognized shows are eligible. Scores must come from judges that are "L" graduates or above.

Score Minimums per Test:

Bronze - Training Level: Junior 64%, Amateur 64%, Open 70%

Bronze - Basic Level: Junior 64%, Amateur 64% Open 70% Western Division

Silver - First Level: Junior 64%, Amateur 64%, Open 68%

Silver - Level One: Junior 64%, Amateur 64%, Open 68% Western Division

Gold - Second Level: Junior 63%, Amateur 63%, Open 66%

Gold - Level Two: Junior 63%, Amateur 63%, Open 66% Western Division
