The Person of God

▶ Biblical Definition of God:

God is a personal, living spirit who is self existent, distinguished from all other spirits by his attributes.

The Person of God

- ►God is spirit John 4:24
- ►God is self existent Acts 17:24-28a; Ex 3:13-14; Rev 1:8, 4:8

The Person of God

- ▶God has personality or personhood
- ▶ 3 elements of personality:
 - 1. Will Eph 1:1
 - 2. Intellect 1 John 3:20b
 - 3. Emotion Gen 6:6

The Person of God

- Because God has personality, He desires a personal relationship with us.
- 1. Through Scripture Ps 32:8; 1 Sam 3:21
- 2. Through His Holy Spirit Rom 8:15,16; Jn14:26
- 3. Through providence Matt 6:25-34; 1 Pet 5:7
- 4. Through creation Rom 1:18-20

- Omniscient all knowing 1 Jn 3:20
- ▶ Omnipresent all present Ps 139:7-12
- Omnipotent all powerful Matt 19:26
- ▶Love 1 Jn 4:8
- ▶ Light 1 Jn 1:5-6
- ► Consuming Fire Heb 12:29

The Foundational Attribute

of God

► Answer: The Holiness of God

►God is Holy:

▶lsa 6:3

▶Ps 19:7

▶1 Pet 1:16

▶Rev 4:8

The Foundational Attribute of God

► Definition of Holiness:

- Holiness is perfection or "wholly other-ness"
- Without fault, blemish, stain, or any defection at all
- ►Without degree

The Foundational Attribute of God

Holiness underlies all else because if God had any blemish or nonperfection at all, then all of the rest of His characteristics could be questioned or brought into doubt.
