I. <u>Introduction</u>: What has Paul said is the way to obtain spiritual maturity, assurance, and access to God?

II. Main Argument

- **A.** New Covenant Life (vv. 15-16): What is the significance of "living under new management"?
 - 1. <u>Peace of Christ (v. 15)</u>:How is this peace related to what we have?
 - a. In what way does this peace rule?
 - **b.** <u>Application</u>: does this peace mean Christians become "doormats" or neither seek nor offer restitution to correct wrongs? How so?
 - **c.** What is the difference between peace *in our hearts* versus peace that *rules* in the heart?
 - **d.** How is this peace reflected in the "holy, catholic, and apostolic Church"?
 - e. <u>Application</u>: How is gratitude to God related to showing grace and knowing peace?
 - **2.** Word of Christ (v. 16)
 - a. What does he mean by "word of Christ" here?
 - 1) Distinguish *honoring* the Word of Christ versus allowing it to *dwell* in you richly:
 - **2)** Application: How do you encourage the word of Christ to dwell richly?
 - **3)** <u>Application</u>: How does this relate to the vows the parents and the congregation make at the baptism of covenant children?

- 4) What is the connection to Eph. 5:18?
- **b.** Who primarily does the teaching in church?
 - 1) How do all Christians teach and admonish one another in the church?
 - 2) What is the connection to Col. 1:9, and what does this teach us about prayer?
- c. Singing and Church Life
 - 1) <u>Application</u>: Why ought singing God's praises be part of the Christian's life?
 - 2) <u>Application</u>: Why ought all Christians participate in the singing of praise to God
 - **3) Application**: Why ought the songs we sing in worship be "singable?
 - **4)** Application: Why ought and why can Christians sing the Psalms?
- **d.** Gratitude: Christian worship is not driven by emotion, but what? Why is that vital?
