MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, January 14, 2021, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all councillors present and Division 3 vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on December 10th, 2020 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of December was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council authorized workers compensation coverage, set the 2021 wages and salaries and acknowledged receipt of the fidelity bond. Grants were issued to St. Raphael's Parish Cemetery, the Town of Carnduff Cemetery, and the Dannevirke Lutheran Church Cemetery. Council opted out of the MHI Spring Weight Restriction Program for 2021 and set the date for the Budget Meeting. Contributions to multiple programs and memberships for 2021 in several organizations were approved. A request for proposal for the supply of diesel fuel was called. Council called for public tender bids for 2021 gravel hauling and spreading. Advertising in local school yearbooks was approved and a cheque was voided. Council also authorized the Alida Fire Chief to purchase some new gear for the fire fighters. Council agreed to allocate the entire population of the RM to the Village of Alida for funding under the 2021 Community Grant Program for Sport, Culture, and Recreation. Council authorized support for SARM's letter to the Federal and Provincial Ministers regarding reliable broadband connectivity in rural Saskatchewan.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

One road right-of-way application was approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:15 p.m.
