## Make It Yours

To get this started just get out all your gear and group it together. Roll clothing inside of sleeping bag and that inside of your water proof poncho liner. This can be strapped on the bottom of you LBH. Remember to pack so that if you have to lightened the load (dump large pack) that the bare necessities are kept on your LBH.

Spend time with your gear so you know what you have. Take it out for a try on a day hike, practice making a shelter see how your set up suits you.

### Customize

Think about your terrain and how it may change. Do you get snow? Do you have prairie, woods or desert? Notice how light effects your terrain, colors blend better when they are lighter as opposed to darker. Try out your camo with a little hide and seek in plain sight. All camo is relative to your environment.

Compass/map Reading glasses/sun Nylon gators/neck gator Bandana/camo compact/face mask Stocking cap/fleece pants/top Gloves/extra socks!

## Large Backpack

Terrain appropriate clothing to cover yourself for cold/wet, a T-shirt can double as a head wrap. For COLD weather layers are required/fleece/gortex.
