with greater amazement and admiration, I then witnessed my body being,

to me like a river, and glory like a flowing stream!

First my arms were supernaturally moved and stretched outward, almost simultaneously! Then my hands were supernaturally and divinely stretched open into the position Christ hands were placed on the cross! Finally, as with the upper part of my body, the lower part of my body was effected! As my legs were supernaturally moved and stretched out together, almost simultaneously! Even my feet were supernaturally driven together, one on top of another, as Christ's feet were placed on the cross!

During this time, I spiritually witnessed and physically experienced myself greatly partaking of the wonderfully divine and precious nature of Christ and God himself. (in reference to John 14:1-23, 26, 27; I Pet. 2:3-7; II Pet. 1:4)! (Note I John 2:23; II John 9) As he literally showed and demonstrated in me his divine and holy feelings and emotions of compassion, tender mercy, and pity toward me and in me in a remarkably gracious and even condescending way, and, therefore; showing himself to be, in fact, extremely "meek and lowly in heart", in reference to Mat. 11:29, and, truly, "merciful", in reference to II Sam. 22:26, in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, in reference to I Cor. 2:1-16, specifically, in reference to verse 4, 13!
