## THEY CAME TO AMERICA TO ESCAPE HARDSHIP AND POVERTY, MOST FOUND WHAT THEY WERE SEEKING AND STAYED. THEY ESTABLISHED GREEK ORTHODOX CHURCHES IN THEIR COMMUNITIES AND PASSED ON A LEGACY OF HELLENIC FAITH AND CULTURE.



"Candy Pete", a Greek sailor, was lured to Wichita, Kansas, for railroad work in 1883. But Pete became ill and the railroad crew left him behind when they moved on. Without railroad work to pay his way, Pete turned to candy-making in 1885. Cero's handmade candies became popular with Wichitans, and Pete's business grew.
