You agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by you to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the cancellation of your participation in the activities and your immediate removal from your horse no matter where that may occur. You understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability as a result of your failure to comply.

4. Show and Class Rules outlined below

It is the exhibitor/rider/handler's responsibility to be aware of and abide by all rules set out in each of the above-mentioned documents.

#### **ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES**

- a) All exhibitors lodging an entry into any West Australian Arabian Horse Association Inc. (WAAHA) event/s shall accept and be bound by these rules upon entering the event.
- b) Competitors are responsible for knowing and complying with all rules and guidelines listed or referred to in this document. It remains the full responsibility of the owner / handler / rider to comply with the equipment rules and general rules as outlined.
- c) Breach of the rules may entail elimination unless other penalties are stipulated.

#### ASSOCIATION LIABILITY

The West Australian Arabian Horse Association Inc (WAAHA) or any of its Agents, shall not be liable for any financial loss or damage, physical injury or property damage suffered by any person or animal by reason of any defect, accident, natural disaster, negligence, or neglect however arising.

Entry to the event is done with the exhibitor/participants knowledge that a pandemic named Covid-19 is still active in Australia and neither The Affiliate, The AHSA Ltd. or the Show Committee will be held liable for any Covid-19 related incident that may occur as a result of participation. All current government restrictions in place at the time of event will be adhered to.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- Entries to events are to be submitted via methods listed in the show schedule and must be accompanied by the correct payment and all supporting documents by close of entries.
- Incorrect and/or incomplete entries that have not been finalised by close of entries will not be accepted. Exhibitors will be sent only one email requesting any outstanding documents, monies etc be forwarded to the show committee.
- Exhibitors must include the names of all persons attending the event as a handler, rider or groom on their entry form.
- By lodging an entry, the exhibitor shall be bound by the terms & conditions of the event. The signature on an entry form by an exhibitor shall be deemed to evidence acceptance of same.

#### **REGISTRATION, OWNERSHIP & MEMBERSHIP**

- All horses must be registered or Performance Index recorded with the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Limited. Registration and Recording numbers to be stated for all exhibits on entry forms. Horses may only compete in classes for the section of the registry in which they hold registration.
- The Society does NOT recognise any form of "pending" registration and horses without a registration or recording number must not be exhibited
- Persons exhibiting any horse, Purebred, Derivative or Performance Index, must be the Registered Owner or Lessee as per the Certificate of Registration or Recording.
- Owners or Lessees of any Arabian, any Arabian Derivative or any Performance Index exhibit MUST be current financial members of the AHSA ltd in order to be eligible to show at an event conducted by AHSA Ltd or any AHSA Ltd Affiliate in classes for Arabian and Arabian bred exhibits.
- Participants/Riders/Handlers who are not the registered owner of the exhibit (or any horse registered or recorded with The AHSA Ltd) may be AHSA Ltd Participant Members.
- All Exhibitors, Riders and Handlers must be current members of AHSA to compete.

#### **WAAHA MEMBERS RATES**

- Only current 2022 Junior, General, Family/Joint and Life members of the WAAHA Inc., whose name appears on the Registration Certificate of an exhibit as the Owner or Lessee, are eligible to enter at WAAHA member's rates.
- Membership fees must be paid before or on the close of entries.
- Non-members of WAAHA competing in Rider/Handler classes must pay non-member rates for those classes regardless of the horse owner's membership status.

#### PERTH POLO CLUB (KINGS MEADOW) - CONDITIONS OF USE

• ALL MANURE, HAY AND RUBBISH MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE GROUNDS BY THE EXHIBITOR.

Do not leave any manure/hay piled around trees or bags full of rubbish/manure/hay on the grounds, IT MUST ALL BE REMOVED BY THE EXHIBITOR.

- Ensure any holes dug by horses are filled in prior to leaving.
- Camping is welcome the toilets and shower will be available for use. There are no powered sites or permanent yards, exhibitors will need to provide their power source and own safe yards if they are camping (must be attached to the float and made of solid panels no electric only fencing). There is to be no camping near the river. There are wash bays and hoses available for use.
- ALL MANURE AND RUBBISH MUST BE REMOVED BY EXHIBITORS. No manure, rubbish or waste, bagged or otherwise is to be left at the
  grounds.

#### REFUNDS

Refunds after the close of entries will only be considered by the show committee where

- application in writing is made to the committee before the commencement of the event outlining the reasons for withdrawal.
- a valid doctors or veterinarian certificate must accompany the above request for the exhibitor / exhibit in question.

If approved, a refund of 50% of class entry fees will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Non-attendance at an event, an exhibit missing a class or being disqualified are not grounds for a refund.

In the case of an exhibitor being required, by law, to self-isolate or be in quarantine due to COVID-19 risk or exposure, a full refund will be provided upon proof of such legal requirement.

#### **STALLIONS**

At all WAAHA events, exhibitors, handlers and riders of stallions will be required to abide by the rules set out in the EA Stallion Safe Practice Rules & Regulations Policy - <a href="https://www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/EA">https://www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/EA</a> Stallion Safe Practice Policy 15062018 0.pdf

Whilst it may not always be possible for green stallion discs to be attached to some in-hand cable halters, it is strongly recommended they be worn in all halter classes.

All stallions will be issued with a green exhibit number which must be worn by the handler / rider in all classes.

#### APPROVED SAFETY HELMET

Any person mounted on a horse is required to wear an approved safety helmet with the retaining harness secured and fastened at all times, in ANY class. Protective headgear must conform with current standards as per Equestrian Australia General Regulations at rule 122.2.

#### **EXHIBIT NUMBERS**

Where entries have been allocated an exhibit number, the exhibit or handler/rider/driver must display the correct exhibit number at all times in each event unless otherwise permitted by a show official.

#### **HEIGHT CERTIFICATES**

Any horse with a current Annual or Life Height Certificates is to compete in the correct height classes. Due to the impact of COVID and no measuring being available at Kings Meadow, for this show, horses who do not have a current height certificate are to compete in the height class of their estimated height. Horses two years and under are to compete in height class of their expected mature height. A copy of the height certificate must be provided with the show entries where applicable.

#### **CLASS RULES**

RIDDEN CLASSES - Horses may compete in Showhorse or Show Hunter classes, not both.

**HALTER CLASSES** – Horses may compete in Showhorse or Performance Horse classes, not both.

Showhorse Class - Horses will be judged on their suitability as a led and / or ridden Showhorse/Show Hunter.

Performance Horse Class – Horses will be judged on their suitability as a Dressage, Jumping/Eventing or Endurance/Racing horse Horses are to be presented in a safe halter or bridle representative of the discipline the horse is suited to. (No Showhorse style ribboned browbands allowed in the Performance Horse Classes)

#### **BEST OF AWARDS**

The winners of each Arabian Derivative registry or Arabian sex class will be eligible to compete for the awards.

#### **FUTURITY CLASS**

Open to horses who are WAAHA Futurity nominated only. Exhibitors must be WAAHA members.

#### **BROODMARE SWEEPSTAKE**

Open to mares 4 years and over who are currently in foal (maiden mares must be at least 120 days in foal), have a foal at foot that she has delivered or have carried a foal who is registered with a breed society (Proof of registration required if the offspring is not registered with AHSA)

If a mare is presented with a foal at foot the foal must be led and must accompany the mare at all times. The foal should not be less than 28 days old and must be handled by a person 16 years of age or older.

Any mare shown should not be more than nine (9) months (275 days) in foal at the date of the show.

70% of all class entry fees will be awarded to the winner and 20% to the runner-up as prize money and or prizes.

#### **OWNER / BREEDER SWEEPSTAKE**

The horse must be owned and exhibited by the breeder. The registered owner name/s must be the same as the breeder's name/s on the horses AHSA Registration certificate.

70% of all class entry fees will be awarded to the winner and 20% to the runner-up as prize money and or prizes.

#### **AUSTRALIAN BRED / AUSTRALIAN RESIDENT**

Australian Bred – Horses must have been born in Australia. Both the sire and dam of the horse must have been resident in Australia at the time of breeding and registered with AHSA.

Australian Resident Sire or Dam Classes – the sire or dam of the horse must have been resident in Australia at the time of breeding and registered with AHSA.

It is irrelevant if the horse was bred using frozen, chilled or fresh semen / live cover.

#### NON-PRO CLASSES See AHSA Rule 16 for the full definition of a Non-Pro

Competitors competing in Non-Pro classes must complete a Non-Pro Declaration form at each event they attend to declare their Non-Pro status.

#### YOUTH CLASSES See AHSA Rule 19 for full definition

- Handler classes Are open to all competitors aged four to seventeen years.
- Ridden classes Are open to all competitors aged five to seventeen years.

Due to the Youth of the Year award, the youth's age will be taken from the 1st January in the year of competition.

Birth certificates will be required for proof of age.

#### **LEADLINE CLASSES** See AHSA Rule 19.2 for full details

Riders must be three to seven years old. Handler must be 18 years or older. Leadline riders cannot compete in any other ridden classes.

#### NEWCOMER CLASSES

A newcomer is a horse that has not competed under saddle in any discipline (with the exception of Racing/Endurance) in any State/Territory before the dates stipulated below. A Pony that has only competed in Leading Rein and has NOT competed off the lead is eligible to be considered a Newcomer. The horse must be ridden in a snaffle bit.

"Qualifying periods"

2021 Newcomers is for horses who competed in their first ridden event between 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2020 (close of entries for the 2020 Newcomer event) and 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021.

2022 Newcomers is for horses who competed in their first ridden event between 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2021 to 9<sup>th</sup> September 2022.

#### **DUAL REGISTERED**

Horses competing in Dual Registered classes must be registered with AHSA and another recognised Breed or Colour Society. Proof of second registration must be provided with show entries where applicable.

#### **WEST COAST CUP**

For registered Arabian and Arabian Derivatives. Arabian Performance Index horses are not eligible to compete.

Horses and riders must be presented in English show hack attire including English saddle and bridle, gloves and the horse to be plaited. Spurs and hacking canes are optional. Dressage whips are not permitted.

Riders may ride a maximum of 2 horses in each class however, all horses must be presented in the ring with a suitably attired rider or handler for presentations.

The Top 5 will be selected by the judge/s. The Runner-up and Winner will then be selected from the Top 5 and presented with their awards. The top five will receive prizemoney.

#### Judging criteria

Horses will enter the arena individually and complete a set workout. At the completion of all workouts, all horses will enter the arena for presentations.

Horses will be scored out of 100 with 0 - 10 points being awarded as follows;

Quality of walk

Quality of trot

Quality of lengthened trot

Quality of canter

Quality of lengthened canter

Quality of halt

Transitions

Conformation and quality as a show hack

Presentation as a show hack

Harmony of horse and rider and overall impression

In the event of a tied score, the horse with the highest score for Harmony of horse and rider and overall impression will be the winner.

Entries for the Official and Unofficial Showhorse event are separate to this event. Entries can be found on the WAAHA and Cavalletti websites. Where possible, classes will be scheduled to prevent horses classes clashing with the Showhorse events.

- c) Speaking at workshops, clinics, seminars or training days in a voluntary capacity where they do not accept a fee for their services.
- d) Receiving prize money or goods as services.
- e) Having the occupation of farrier, veterinarian, stable hand or groom.
- f) Owning or operating a saddlery, stud or breeding farm or boarding stables.

Spouses and immediate family of a trainer are also able to be registered as a Non-Pro, providing they are not involved with any of the above listed activities with horses where the trainer is being paid.
