



Code of Conduct

The purpose of Canning Arts Group (CAG) is to establish, conduct and maintain an association of an educational, recreational, social and non-political character for the purpose of promoting and fostering all forms of art and crafts and to foster fellowship, and shall include:

- Holding classes for members in various arts and crafts;
- Further educating members in the field of art and crafts by holding various classes, workshops and lectures by prominent artists and crafts-persons;
- Providing an outlet for members' work by holding displays, exhibitions, sales of work and other such activities as may from time to time be decided;

All members of the Association shall be bound by this Code of Conduct.

Members have a right to:

- Be treated fairly, equally and with respect by the Association, its Committee and other members;
- Socialise in an environment free from all forms of harassment and discrimination;
- Privacy and confidentiality concerning records, documentation and any other communication containing a member's personal information, unless consent is otherwise provided;
- Be informed and actively involved in all club events and offerings;
- Voice their opinions, requirements and suggestions to the Committee;

Members must:

- Treat other members, guests, staff and other patrons fairly, equally and with respect and courtesy;
- Behave responsibly and ensure they conduct themselves in a manner which will not injure the reputation of CAG, its events, organisers, participants or sponsors.
- Not physically or verbally harass others;
- Report any inappropriate behaviour of a member to the CAG Committee for action and follow up;
- Abide by the CAG Code of Conduct and uphold the Rules of Association;
- Pay any fees in relation to an event which that member has committed to;
- Notify CAG's Secretary of any changes to address or other details;
- Not use their membership privileges to purchase tickets to any event or other offering, at a membership price, for non members of the Association (except for parties entitled to such prices as nominated from time to time).

Breaches of this Code of Conduct:

- Any member not behaving in accordance with the terms of the Code of Conduct at an event of CAG may be asked to leave and will not be entitled to a refund of any monies paid;
- The inappropriate behaviour of any members will be investigated, discussed and an appropriate course of action as set out in the Rules of Association will be taken by the Committee, which may be subject to a reprimand, suspension or revocation of membership.
