Part I

My Testimony of the Demonstration of the Resurrection of the Spirit of Christ Rising Up and Lifting Me Up Within My Body

Sunday, in the year 1977, the very same day I literally experienced the demonstration of light and power within my heart and soul, in reference to I Cor 2:1-4, (note verses 5-16), as in Heb. 5:5-14:

soon after arriving home from church service, I was led and inspired to fast, and later that evening, to pray to my heavenly Father. I prayed "the Lord's prayer exactly as it is written in the bible, "the King James Version". And, while sitting on the floor, reading this prayer aloud without ceasing, continually meditating earnestly on every word, in reference to Luke 11:2-4. As it is written:

- Luke 11:1 And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples.
- 2 And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name, Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.
- **3** Give us day by day our daily bread.
- **4** And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us, And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.

While I was praying with Dusan, my first newborn child, lying near me, I experienced another, yet much more intensely felt miraculous, heavenly wonder occur within my body! (Note Rev. 12:1,2,5) That is, I experienced an intensely great and

mighty spiritual act, in reference to Is. 28:21, as in a wonderful demonstration of the Spirit and of power, again, in reference to I Cor. 2:1-13, specifically in reference to verse 4!

Suddenly, taking me completely by surprise and not being at all in control of what was occurring at that moment within me, I was in unquestionable awe as I began to witness and physically experience my spirit gently, yet amazingly powerfully, being spiritually transformed and changing!

This experience was a physical and spiritual feeling of gradually losing my earthly sense of weight and gravity increasingly feeling a sense of a wonderful heavenly and angelic weightlessness. That is, every part of my body felt literally **changed and transformed** into that of a holy, spiritual and heavenly body, according to the word of God, the Holy Scriptures, and demonstrated within me in the way these words of the bible are literally and accurately defined, in reference to I Cor. 15:51,52, note Is.44:23-28. **For they are the living words of the spirit and they are life**, in reference to John 6:63: John 1:1-4 and I John 1-3. For it is written:

John 6:62 RWhat and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before? Eph. 4:7-13
63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

To further explain in greater depth the meaning of the Holy Scriptures emphasizing the way accurately defined scriptures relate to, interpret and confirm my testimonies, note the following:

In reference to I Corinthians 15:51,52 stated above, "**change**" is defined: v.t. 1. To make different; alter; transmute. – v.i. 5. To become different; vary. 6. To enter upon a new phase: *the moon has changed*. 7. To make a change or exchange. – n. 1. The act or fact of changing: alteration: substitution or something used in substitution. 8. Religious conversion. Synonyms (verb): alter, commute, convert, exchange, ...transfigure, ¹transform, ...turn...

Transformed is defined: v.t. 1. To give a different form to: change the character of. 2. To alter the nature of: convert. 4. Elect. a) To change the potential or the type of, as a current from higher to lower voltage, or from alternating to direct. b) To alter the energy form of, as electrical into mechanical. – 6. To be or become changed in form or character.

^{1.1}**Revolution** is defined: according to Random House Webster's College Dictionary, 1. a complete and forcible overthrow and replacement of an established government or political system by the people governed. 2. <u>a sudden, complete, or radical change in something.</u> 3. <u>a procedure or course, as if in a circuit, back to a starting point.</u> 4.a a turning round or rotating, as on an axis. 6. moving in a circular or curving course, as about a central point. 6. a cycle of events in time or in a recurring period of time.

During this time while I was experiencing this heavenly, holy, and angelic weightlessness, gradually and then simultaneously, I felt my spirit being literally raptured and transported upward. That is, I felt my spirit being lifted up and rising up high within my body: gently rising and ascending up high spiritually, though physically I remained on the floor. Being in the state of awe and fear that I was dieing, as my concern was for my

newborn, Dusan, who laid close by me. Yet shortly after, I realized I was not dieing, but remained perfectly conscious and very much alert and alive.

This was the very real and literal sensation of being moved and raised up high in my spirit in a celestial, heavenly, holy and supernaturally divine way, feeling spiritually and **supernaturally** affected by the undeniable glory and power of God! In this way, I felt marvelously and wonderfully transformed "like his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able to **subdue** all things unto himself." in reference to Phil. 3:21, and while being in awe, I was and am "**subject**" to him", in reference to I Cor. 15:28; Eph. 1:19,20; 2:5,6. As mentioned above:

Supernatural is defined: 1. of, pertaining to, or being above or beyond what is natural or explainable by natural law. 2. of, pertaining to, or attributed to God or a diety. (Note Is. 45:3 and v. 13. Also, again, note I Cor. 2:1-16. specif. vs. 12-16.)

Moments later, I sensed I was no longer moving upward, just being still, feeling spiritually elevated high and gloriously exalted, in the true meaning of the word! At this point, my body felt entirely spiritual, celestial, and of this heavenly weight! Truly, this was the sensation of living in heaven as the angels and being caught up in the air spiritually, in reference to Luke 20:36; I Thes. 4:17, where I literally felt I was sitting on "the throne of glory, in reference to I Sam. 2:8; Mat. 19:28; Mat. 25:31; Rev. 3:21; 5:13! As in I Cor. 15:43, "raised in glory" and , II Cor. 3:18, "changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord". I must add, this was not the same or equal to any artificially induced high caused by drugs or alcohol for example, which is only the counterfeit experience of being spiritually high.

Finally, ten to fifteen (10-15) minutes or so later, I began to feel my spiritual body gradually being transported downward, from a heavenly realm to the earthly realm: Reference Books Used: King James Holy Bible; Webster's New World Dictionary; Britannica World Language-Edition of Funk & Wagnalls Standard Dictionary

spiritually descending and returning to the floor, as in the material, terrestrial and earthly realm. As this occurred, I began to feel normal as usual. That is, within a short period of time, I no longer felt this intense sensation of heavenly weightlessness, nor the sensation of feeling celestially and spiritually high.

Although not as intensely as the first time, but since that day, from time-to-time I continue to feel this same sensation of being spiritually raised up high in my spirit, feeling spiritually exalted, in reference to II Sam. 22:34; Is. 33:5,16; John 6:63; I Cor. 15:45,47. Therefore, again, in reference to the word of my testimony compared with the Holy Scriptures and also of the Holy Spirit, they are in agreement and are the same, as in reference to Is. 44:23-28, specif. v. 26 and I John 5:6-10.

Therefore, the testimony, meaning, evidence and or proof, in the Bible, a) the tables of the law: Ex. 25:16, (note Acts 7:35-38; Rom. 9:1-33; Heb. 8:1-13, specif. vs. 5,10,13 & Is. 28:9-23,26,29), b) the precepts of God, (note Ps. 119:4), of Christ was confirmed, (meaning, proven and demonstrated to be a fact and experienced), in me, in reference to I Cor. 1:6, as in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, in reference to Deut. 18:5,15-22, (esp. note v. 22) and I Cor. 2:1-16, specifically, verse 4, therefore, being the testimony and witness of Christ and the holy apostles and prophets of Christ, in reference to John 3:1-13,31-34, (in reference to verse 13, note Eph. 2:5,6; 4:6-13); John 8:12-19; Eph. 2:20; 3:1-10; I John 1:1-5, as in Chapters 4-15: My Testimonies of Christ and of God: Scriptures of Confirmation and Interpretation, the refore, confirmed by the holy scriptures, in reference to Is. 44:6-8, (note vs. 9-11), 23-28, specif. v. 26; Rom. 16:25-27; II Tim. 3:15,16, and thereby proven to be true, as we are true witnesses that he is, truly, come manifest in our flesh, in reference to John 14:1-21, note 16:7-11); I John 4:2,4,13,14, (note verse 3), as God himself is our witness, in reference to John 5:31-44; Rom. 8:16; Heb. 2:4; 10:15-22; I John 5:6-10,20; Rev. 3:14!
