# Happy Resurrection Day! Let's Keep the Celebration Going!!!

Hello, Partners and Friends,

Happy Resurrection Day!

What a day to celebrate! We celebrate because this is the day that Jesus rose from the dead. He's not dead – He's yet alive! I am reminded of the chorus to this beautiful song often sung at Easter:

He lives (He lives), He lives (He lives), Christ Jesus lives today. He walks with me and talks with me Along life's narrow way. He lives (He lives), He lives (He lives), Salvation to impart. You ask me how I know He lives -He lives within my heart!

What a beautiful song! It takes me back to my childhood years. This was always such an uplifting song – gave me warm fuzzies to know that I was never alone, and that Jesus lived in my heart. I always took comfort knowing that I was carrying Jesus around in my heart. I thank God for the revelation I had that Jesus was always with me – but it was a revelation that *Jesus-was-always-with-me-to-keep-me-company* kind of thing. I did not know then what I know now.

Do you remember a few months ago, when I wished you a Merry Christmas the day *after* Christmas? God was showing us through the timing of that letter that Christmas is not something to be celebrated one day, one month, or even one season of the year. Christmas is to be celebrated all year long. Why?

Quick Review:

- Christmas = *Christ* + *mas*:
  - Christ (The Anointed One and His Anointing) + Mas (Celebration) = Christmas (Celebration of the Anointed One and His Anointing).
- Popular Christmas verse Luke 2:11:
  - For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.



• Where is Christ (the Anointed One and His Anointing) now?

➤ …Christ <u>in you</u>, the hope of glory (Col. 1:27).

God showed us that Christmas was not just a one-time-of-the-year celebration. Rather, it is an all-the-time celebration: even though we associate Christmas with the birth of Christ, the celebration is actually the celebration of Christ Himself. His birth was just the beginning.

I remember when I first got this revelation. God revealed to me that Jesus' birth, while worthy of celebration, was not enough to save mankind. If it hadn't been for Easter (or Resurrection Day, as I now call it), we would have nothing to celebrate at all.

I don't know about you, but most of the Easter messages I heard growing up centered on John 3:16: For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. I learned that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, but that He did not stay dead – He rose again! He was alive!

And, though it was a GREAT celebration, that's where the celebration ended: Jesus was alive. I did not know then what I am about to share with you. (You may know this already, but I ask that you hear it with fresh ears and receive it afresh.) Ready?



Not only is Jesus alive, but He's alive IN ME! If you've made Jesus your Lord, He's alive IN YOU! Hallelujah!!! <u>THIS</u> is why Christmas is not a once-a year celebration! <u>THIS</u> is why we are

to keep the celebration going! Jesus Christ - the Anointed One and His Anointing, the One Whom we celebrate - is alive, and He's alive IN YOU and IN ME!

So, how do we keep the celebration going? I'm so glad you asked!

The Lord gave me four things to share with you. He says that if we do these four things, we will develop the discipline of walking in humility that gives Him ultimate glory and allows us to experience His "all grace" (see II Cor. 9:8).

## 1) Acknowledge the Christ in you (Col. 1:27, Philemon 6).

Acknowledging that the Anointed One and His Anointing is in you a) increases your awareness of Him, and b) positions you to grow closer to Him.

#### 2) Follow and obey the Christ in you (Luke 6:46, John 2:5).

It behooves us to follow and obey the Anointed One and His Anointing because He is the Way, the Truth, the Life, and the Access (John 8:12).

- He is the Way to approach every situation; the Way to get it done; the Way to achieve desired results.
- He is the Truth that supersedes fact; the Truth that sanctifies us to God; the Truth that makes us free from whatever is trying to hinder us or take us out.
- He is the God-quality of life; the abundant life; the victorious life.
- He is the One by which we gain access to the Father and to all that He has for us.

## 3) Depend on the Christ in you (Gal. 2:20-21, Phil. 4:13).

To depend on ourselves would be to throw away everything Jesus accomplished for us for granted. (Gal. 2:21). It would be to think of ourselves more highly than we ought to – as if we can do more for ourselves than God can (Rom. 12:3). It would be to disqualify ourselves from the grace that God so much wants to show us (James 4:6, I Pet. 5:5). But to depend on the Anointed One and His Anointing within us is to know that, while without Him we can do nothing, with Him we can do all things. Hallelujah!

## 4) Allow the Christ in you to be all that He is through you (Eph. 3:20).

The only limit God has in our lives is the limit we put on Him. He longs to show us the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His power in and for us (Eph. 1:19, KJV). He is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, <u>according to the power that worketh in us</u> (*i.e., according to the degree that we yield to the Anointed One and His Anointing within us*) (Eph. 3:20). The more we yield to Christ by following the three steps above, the more we will allow Him to be all that He is in and through us, the more we will experience the greatness of God's power in our lives.

When we celebrate Jesus Christ – the Anointed One and His Anointing – by these four steps, we are allowing God to be everything that He wants to be in us and to do everything that He

wants to do through us. Let's celebrate by walking in the anointing of Jesus Christ and allowing God to do His work through us just like He did through Jesus. Amen? (Respond out loud: Amen! (2))

If you have been blessed by what you have just read, **OR**, if you have been *challenged* by what you just read - I would like to encourage you to give, or to "sow on it." **Name your seed in faith and expect to receive a harvest of it in your life.** Just as you would plant corn seeds if you wanted to harvest corn, plant the seed you want to harvest. If you are believing God for your groceries, name the seed "Groceries," sow it in faith, and expect to see the harvest of that seed (i.e., you having enough to buy groceries for your family and for someone else, too, because the harvest is always greater than the seed). If you are believing for favor on your job, name the seed "Favor." If you are believing for health in your body or salvation for a loved one, name your seed accordingly - whatever you are believing God for. I stand in agreement with you that God will grant your request according to His will, in Jesus' Name.

As you prepare to sow your next seed (sowing outlets are listed at the end of this letter), sow it in faith as demonstration that you believe you receive a harvest of this Word in your life.
