



Just like the Lexile Measure, Quantile Measures vary from 0Q to 2000Q. Based on the Quantile Measure of your child, you can identify extensive targeted resources to help your child in math on the different topics.

There are plenty of FREE videos, interactive games, and other resources that are appropriate to your child's Quantile measure.

Educators say the resources are in your child's **zone of proximal development**.

Use the FREE Find a Book Tool

Lexile Measures vary from BR400L to 2000L. Every child is unique. They have their own interests.

First, you can narrow the selection of what your child reads based on the interest **Categories** of your child. You can choose from (i) Animals, Bugs & Pets; (ii) Art, Creativity, & Music; (iii) Fiction, Non-fiction, & Poetry; (iv) Hobbies, Sports, & Outdoors; (v) Science Fiction & Fantasy; (vi) Real Life; (vii) Science & Technology; (viii) Mystery & Suspense; to (ix) Reference.

Second, you can then further filter by numerous **Subcategories** that interest your child/children.

Third, you may have access to a local library to read the EBooks, Watch Movies, Listen to Audio Books for FREE. You can also access more resources through TexShare Databases.

The 7Cs Story

- 1. You know the 7Cs **Triangle Model**. Individual **C**reativity along with two sides of the 7Cs *Knowledge Coin*-**C**ompetencies and **C**ritical Thinking; two sides of the 7Cs *Skills Coin* **C**ommunication and **C**ollaboration; and two sides of the 7Cs *Attitudes Coin* **C**haracter and **C**itizenship.
- 2. 7Cs started as the **Designing**Learning Model in 2005. This model accelerates learning for every child.
 Children make two or more years of academic growth in one semester.
 Designing Learning is based on cognitive and neuroscience research.
- 3. 7Cs Triangle Model and the Designing Learning Model thrive in **Pasteur's Quadrant**. Pasteur's Quadrant combines two elements: research AND use. I like this quote of Louis Pasteur: "When I approach a child, she or he inspires in me two sentiments; (i) tenderness for what she or he is; and (ii) respect for what she or he may become."
- 4. The movie **The Story of Louis Pasteur** beautifully shows the
 struggles of Pasteur and how he
 proves to skeptical doctors that
 microbes are the cause of all disease.
 I highly recommend you see this
 movie with your children. It is timely
 and free on **Amazon Prime**.
- **5. Neils Bohr** and Albert Einstein were research focused. To give you an idea of these two great minds, here is an interesting exchange between them.

Einstein to Bohr - God does not play dice.

Bohr - Einstein, stop telling God what to do.

Our Vision at 7CsThrive is to develop socially responsible citizens.





Dr. B: Tatum, do you like Animals, Bugs, & Pets? **Tatum**: I love Animals, Bugs & Pets.


Dr. B: Nice, you like reading about
