has a rich heritage of indigenous performance especially in the areas of dancing, drama, storytelling, and ceremonies which incorporate music, dancing, masks, costumes, and some short dramatic scenes. All of these are community based and very good at emphasizing community. A major type of theatre is the Concert Party which parallels the Yoruba Opera and was the first fully professional theatre in Ghana.

The Concert Party includes jokes, singing, dancing, and has come from many sources. Efua Sutherland was the most important female writer figure in Ghanaian theatre after independence. She wrote *Vulture!* Another famous female writer was Ama Ata Aidoo ? Joe C. All of which highlighted traditional values and African to white relationships. Mohammed Ben-Hbdallah ? She was also a major part in the creating of a National Theatre. Universities and the Ghana government were major assistants to the theatre. Despite this there is little professional theatre still alive in Ghana. Is that this a paid subject or did you customize it your self? I customized this blog myself. It was part of my grade for my High School senior year theatre and film study. I appreciate that you enjoyed it. This book did actually go into more detail on theatres from around the world.
