Cannon River Lutheran Church Council Meeting June 9, 2022

The Cannon River Lutheran Church Council met on June 9, 2022. Present were Interim Pastor Dan Nordin, Bill Bodin, David Fremouw, Mark Hartman, and Michelle Sandeen. Absent: Shawn Klahr and Sharon Niebur.

Prior to the start of our Council Meeting, Council met with Cross of Christ Council members and Call Committee members representing both congregations. Call Committee Co-Chairs Ellen Hartman and Jim Gustafson went over the Ministry Site Profile for both churches. After the review of the Ministry Site Profile, Council members from both congregations met separately to discuss the profiles. A motion was made by Mark Hartman, second by David Fremouw, to approve the Ministry Site Profile for Cannon River Lutheran. Both Councils met again and Interim Pastor Dan Nordin briefly explained the call process.

The Cannon River Lutheran Church Council meeting was officially called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Interim Pastor Dan led us in devotions.

Minutes from the May 12, 2022 meeting were read. Motion made by Michelle Sandeen, second by David Fremouw to approve the May 12, 2022 minutes.

Treasurer's report for the month of May was read. Motion by Mark Hartman, second by David Fremouw to approve the May treasurer's report.

## **Old Business:**

Michelle commented on the Welcome banners/flags for the lawn in front of the church. Michelle and Sharon looked at numerous church signs. An option besides a banner or flag is to put "All are welcome" in the "white space" on our current sign. Discussion will be held in the future once a new pastor is on board.

There is a little work left to do on the annex door, and the ballast was replaced downstairs.

### New Business:

A few items that were brought to the attention of Councilmember Niebur are as follows:

There were questions surrounding the sewer back-up from a few years ago. The sewer back-up was repaired and pumped.

The restroom signs are positioned too low to be seen when the basement is full of people. It was suggested that we look at getting bigger "restroom" signs.

A few dead mice were found in a drawer in the kitchen. Currently there are a few mouse traps located throughout. It was suggested that we look into an electronic sound box to help keep mice from entering the church. Another question arose whether or not there should be a defibrillator on-site. Sometimes we have large crowds for funerals and the church is located several miles from town. Michelle is going to talk to the Emergency Management Services Chief in Cannon Falls to inquire on defibrillators and bring the information to the August meeting.

The outdoor worship service will be held on Saturday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. Look for details in the Chronicles.

Our next meeting will be held on August 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. at Cannon River.

A motion was made by Mark Hartman, second by David Fremouw to adjourn the meeting.



## **Financial News:**

Our churches have been fortunate in recent years to have pastors that have agreed to compensation well below the synod guidelines. We cannot expect that trend to continue. According to synod guidelines, a pastor with 10 years of experience should be compensated around **\$25,000 more than we were paying Deacon Todd** just two years ago. This pastoral compensation would increase our monthly expenses by over \$2,000. Even without this added expense, we have already developed an \$18,000 deficit since Jan. 1.

In May, **\$11,000 was transferred** from the Money Market Account to the checking account to offset the deficit. This transfer is shown

in the 3<sup>rd</sup> bar under May in the graph. The \$11,000 originated as parsonage rental income. We plan to continue to transfer \$1,000/month of parsonage rental income to the operating fund, but this is only a portion of what we need to cover our operating costs.

#### Cross of Christ Council Meeting Minutes *Faithful Through Generations* June 9, 2022

Prior to the start of our Council Meeting, Council met with Cannon River Council members and Call Committee members representing both congregations. Call Committee Co-Chairs Ellen Hartman and Jim Gustafson went over the Ministry Site Profile for both churches. After the review of the Ministry Site Profile, Council members from both congregations met separately to discuss the profiles. *A motion was made and second to approve the Ministry Site Profile for Cross of Christ Lutheran Church* -Motion Passed. Both Councils returned together again, and Pastor Dan briefly explained the call process.

Meeting was called to order by Council President Joan Slingsby and mission statement was read.

Agenda was approved and the May minutes were approved with the correction of council person of the month name change.

#### Unfinished Business

\*Pastors report:

Dan touched base on the change of roll for him once the MSP's are submitted to the Synod and the Call Committee turns to the interviewing process

\*Building Vision Committee: A meeting is scheduled for June 16<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.

\*150 Year Church Anniversary Committee:

Ann provided a list of approximately 12 persons who are willing to serve on the committee. A meeting to get things going will be scheduled in June. <u>News Business</u> \*July Council person – Joan Slingsby \*Brass Bell Ringing: It was suggested when ringing the bell, to ring approximately five times with a 5 second delay between rings. \*Church Softball League: The fee for The Church Softball League is \$275. *A motion was made and seconded to pay the \$275 league fee.* -Motion Passed.

#### Committee Reports

Finance: Rebecca gave a report of the current financials. During an earlier meeting at the end of May it was discussed to transfer funds from the council discretionary fund (which is mostly gathered from the overflow of the parsonage expense fund) and move \$11,000 into the operating fund to offset the current deficit. It was also discussed to use \$1,000 monthly from the rent monies to go into the operating fund. *A motion was made and seconded make a one time transfer of funds from the council discretionary fund to the operating fund.* **-Motion Passed.** 

A motion was made and seconded to transfer \$1,000 monthly from the rent funds to the operating fund. -Motion Passed. A motion was made and seconded to approve the financial secretary reports. -Motion Passed.

#### Property Management:

Oscar replaced the hinges on the main sanctuary door, and it now closes properly. He has also moved a few loads of brush off the premises, mowing was completed again. Joan mentioned Sargents has returned and completed their job, including a pathway like ramp to the cemetery for funerals. Deanna has suggested purchasing a small carpet cleaner for easy clean up of messes or accidents. She presented Bissell's Little Green machine for \$79. *A motion was made and seconded to move forward in purchasing the carpet cleaner.* -Motion Passed.

Worship & Music:

A meeting is scheduled for June 26<sup>th</sup> following worship. The event

guidelines were reviewed. Under the custodial fees, an addition of a second fee in the amount of \$50, if more than one hall is used during any event at the church for overflow. *A motion was made and seconded to approve the addition of a \$50 fee for overflow usage in a second hall during an event.* -Motion Passed.

Learning & Youth: A VBS planning meeting is scheduled for June 28<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm. VBS July 10-14. Helpers are still needed, please contact Julie.

Missions: Karen Anderson will not be able to join us this year. The *"One Sole at Time"* shoe collection box is up at the back of church. Let's fill it up!!

Stewardship: Temple talk by Bob Luhman will be held during worship on June 26<sup>th</sup>.

Personnel: All personnel reviews have been completed.

The meeting was adjourned, and the Lord's Prayer was said.

The next meeting will be held at 6:30pm on Tuesday, August 9<sup>th</sup>.


