Improvements to Gillespie Park set to commence

Following a successful meeting with the then Chief Minister, John Stanhope early in 2010 ongoing discussions have been held to determine what amenities would benefit our community, using the \$100,000 he made available.

Following community consultation your committee came up with several concepts for improvements to Gillespie Park.. It is good to report that those improvements have now been agreed and work on Stage I is to commence soon.

Stage I involves a new picnic shelter to match the existing Gazebo. Nearby there will be a double electric barbeque and a new accessible picnic setting. Several walls are to be built for both effect and seating and the area of the park nearest Railway Street is to be fenced to prevent children using the facilities from running on to the road. A new interpretive sign outlining the history of the immediate area is to be erected and some placement of fresh gravel on the paths is to occur.

Next year further work will be undertaken as Stage 2 of the project. Stage 2 involves the renewal of the play equipment, new entry paving, fixing of paths, painting the new light poles a more pleasing colour and regressing areas disturbed by the works.
