## March Newsletter

### Dear SonShine Families,

It's March already! Time flies when you're enjoying life with preschoolers. Thank you, parents, for sending things for our Valentine's Day Parties. On behalf of all the teachers, thank you for all the lovely Valentines!

Classes are filling quickly for fall! If you or your friends have children to enroll for fall, we encourage you to do so soon!

### Easter Parties March 31 & April 1

Our Easter parties will be student-only events, but we will once again have a mini-concert for families at the end of class times in the main church auditorium! Please arrive 15 minutes before class ends, and pick a socially distanced seat.

We will have an Easter Egg hunt as one of our party rotation activities, as well as hardboiled egg decorating. Each child will bring some hardboiled eggs to decorate in class, and some filled plastic eggs for the hunt.

Each child gets to bring their Easter Basket on party day for the hunt!

Easter party food sign-up sheets will be on the counter closer to Easter. Please, NO NUTS or PEANUT BUTTER candies in the filled Easter eggs.

### Illnesses

You have all been great about keeping kids home when ill, so thank you! If they or a household member has a pending COVID test due to symptoms, please keep them home.

### Shoes

Most preschoolers are not yet capable of tying their shoes. They should come to school in easy, non-lace-up shoes. It takes a lot of time away when teachers have to constantly re-tie shoes. Please have mercy on the teachers and don't send kids in lace-up shoes. Thank you for your consideration.

### Gloves & Jackets

Remember, we have outside recess most days. Our general rule of thumb is if it's 20 degrees or warmer, we go outside, so please leave a jacket every day that it's cold. Even if it's an inside recess day, they still need a jacket in case of evacuation.

Please label gloves and jackets! If you're sending gloves from home, it's helpful to have them in your child's jacket pockets, ready to go for recess, so they don't have to dig in backpacks.

We do have lots of school gloves for anyone who doesn't bring gloves. If you have missing gloves and they're not on the lost & found rack, please ask us and we can check our class glove bin- sometimes children accidentally put their personal gloves in the class glove laundry hamper by mistake.
