

# SAINTS

In Babylonian times they believed that “saints” were all mortal men who lived on earth at one time, just like the Catholics believe. Saint for fever termination was St. George.

Some of the Roman heathen gods were re-named by the Catholic church with like sounding names; as in Cheron and St. Ceranos and Bright and St. Bridget.
