OPTION 2 — "Monarto Safari Park" (Saturday Only)

This is a self-drive scenic tour largely following the Old Princes Highway to the world famous Monarto Safari Park - one of the largest safari experiences outside Africa covering 1500 hectares and home to more than 50 species of native animals and many of Africa's most iconic and impressive animals.

Here is what you need to know:

- Select this tour option at the time of REGISTRATION and pay the required cost of \$60pp (Includes a boxed Lunch and drink).
- 8.45am. Designated meeting place FULL DETAILS IN YOUR RALLY BOOK!— collect your tickets and boxed lunch.
- **9:00am.** Depart Hahndorf in loose convoy (47 km/40 mins.) to Monarto Safari Park.
- **9:40am.** Arrive Monarto Safari Park (ample car parking) and enjoy a coffee at the café in the new Visitor Centre.

10:00am. The day is yours. Board the hop-on, hop-off bus. (buses run every 15-20 mins approx. – (No eating or drinking on the bus) Hop-on or off as many times as you like. A full sight seeing circuit option (no getting off) takes about 90 minutes; however, there are five recommended viewing stops – Cheetah, The Outpost, The Waterhole, The Bomas and Windara.
